



READ (Luke 19:37-38)

WE OFTEN REMEMBER THIS SPOT...

- As the location of Jesus' *Triumphal Entry*.

The fulfillment of (Zech 9:9)...

“Rejoice, O people of Zion! Shout in triumph, O people of Jerusalem! Look, your king is coming to you. He is righteous and victorious. Yet He is humble, riding on a donkey – riding on a donkey’s colt.”

~ THE FINAL SEVEN MOVEMENTS OF JESUS’ LIFE ~

1st – The upper room for the **last supper** (Matt 26:18).

2nd – After supper they **sang a hymn** (Matt 26:30).

3rd – And headed to the Mount of Olives... specifically (Matt 26:36)
Garden of Gethsemane.

4th – Jesus is seized and taken to **Caiaphas’s house** – the High Priest (Matt 26:57).

5th – Then in the early morning hours Jesus was taken to **Pontius Pilate** Governor (Matt 27:1-2).

6th – by 9:00am in the morning Jesus had been **put on a Roman Cross** (Golgotha) (Matt 27:33-35).

7th – Laid in Josephs new tomb (Matt. 27:60).

***Gordons Calvary** - British General Charles Gordon (1883 AD) claimed this site as the Protestant alternative to the Holy Sepulcher.

****Church of the Holy Sepulcher** is the authentic / historic location, which was outside the gates in a rock quarry during Jesus’ day.

No matter which location you visit, the tomb is empty, which is the main point! He is alive – Resurrected!

~ THREE LESSONS IN FAITH ~

1st – in (Ezk. 11:23) The Spirit of the LORD leaves the Temple and stopped on the Mount of Olives.

Ezekiel's vision says, *Then the glory of the LORD went up from the city and stopped above the mountains to the east.*” (Mount of Olives)

2nd – In (Acts 1:9-11) the ascension of Christ took place on the Mount of Olives.

“... He was taken up into a cloud while they were watching, and they could no longer see Him. As they strained to see Him rising into heaven, two white robed men suddenly stood among them. Men of Galilee, why are you standing here staring into heaven? Jesus has been taken from you into heaven, but someday He will return from heaven in the same way you saw Him go!”

3rd – Jesus will return to the Mount of Olives to set up His kingdom (Zech 14:4)

On that day His feet will stand on the Mount of Olives, east of Jerusalem. And the Mount of Olives will split apart, making a wide valley running from east to west. Half the mountain will move toward the north and half toward the south.”
