I. Title: Living in the Freedom of Grace!

II. Scripture: Romans 6:1-14

III. Central Idea: Believers are called to live in the freedom of grace, rejecting sin and embracing their new life in Christ.

IV. Outline.

1. Baptized Into Christ. Romans 6:1-4

A. The believer has died to sin. Vs. 2

B. The believer has been baptized into Christ. Vs. 3

C. The believer has been baptized into Christ's death. Vs. 3

D. The believer has been buried with Christ. Vs. 4

2. Bondage to Freedom Romans 6:5-7

A. The believer has been resurrected with Christ. Vs. 4-5

B. The believer was crucified with Christ. Vs. 6

C. The believer has been set free from sin. Vs.6-7

3. Alive With Christ. Romans 6:8-10

A. The believer has been set free to live righteously. Vs. 8

B. The believer has been set free from death. Vs. 9

C. The believer lives for the Glory of God. Vs. 10

4. Actively Alive in Grace. Romans 6:11-14

A. The believer is called to reject sin by God's grace.

B. The believer is called to be holy by God's grace.
