

Saray Luciana Mancilla and Itzel Mancilla - Candidates for Baptism

Biography written by their Aunt Gladys

Itzel and Saray Luciana Mancilla were born in New York to their parents, Teresa Gálvez and Oscar Mancilla. When the girls reached school age—Itzel at 7 and Saray at 4—their parents made the difficult decision to move to Ocotlán Chila de la Sal, Puebla, Mexico, Teresa's hometown.

They made this choice because the girls' maternal grandparents, Manuel Gálvez and María Chávez, became ill and needed care. While the family was there, their grandmother passed away, and the girls began school in Mexico. Their parents worked planting crops and living off the land. Itzel and Saray completed both primary and secondary school there, and their parents quickly saw how much they loved learning through their strong grades.

The older sister, Itzel, began to dream of returning to the United States to continue her education, but her parents could not return because they do not have legal residency. Shortly before Itzel graduated, I received a call from their father, Oscar Mancilla, asking if I would be willing to take Itzel into my home so she could study. I gladly agreed, believing everyone deserves a chance. After talking with my daughters—who were happy to welcome her—we brought Itzel home. On July 25, 2024, at 9:00 p.m., we picked her up at LAX.

The following summer, Saray arrived as well, on July 24, 2025, with the same goal of continuing her education. Because the girls spent many years in Mexico, they are still learning English. Both girls love school, and I never have to remind them to do their homework or go to bed on time. They are disciplined, respectful, and kind—quiet, but full of heart. Itzel was born on June 20, 2007. Saray Luciana was born on April 27, 2010.

Their parents are Seventh-day Adventists and accepted the faith while living in New York, where they were baptized. One of their father's greatest wishes was for his daughters to grow in their faith, attend church, and one day be baptized. When he learned they had decided to take Bible classes and prepare for baptism, he thanked God with joy.

Our families are connected through their father, who is the brother of my daughters' father—so Itzel and Saray are our nieces and cousins.

They have joyfully become involved in church and will soon be official members of Glendale City Adventist Church. Thank you to everyone who has welcomed them so warmly and shown them such love and kindness. On behalf of their parents, we are deeply grateful to Pastor Rebecca for conducting Bible Studies, and to all the sisters in the kitchen for their care and support.
