

2026 Bible Reading Guide - “Our Mighty God” (Pt 1-16 Weeks)

Week 1 – Our God Of New Beginnings

- **Genesis 1** – God begins creation by His word, showing He is the initiator of all life and purpose.
- **Matthew 1** – God begins His redemptive plan through the birth and lineage of Jesus.
- **Ezra 1** – God stirs hearts to begin restoration after exile.
- **Acts 1** – God launches a new work through the promise of the Holy Spirit and the church.
- **Psalm 40** – God brings new beginnings by lifting us out of despair and setting us on firm ground.

Week 2 – Our God Who Knows and Purposes Our Lives

- **Genesis 2** – God personally forms humanity and gives purpose to life.
- **Matthew 2** – God guides events and people to protect His plan and His Son.
- **Ezra 2** – God knows His people individually and brings them back with purpose.
- **Acts 2** – God forms a Spirit-filled community with intentional design.
- **Psalm 139** – God knows us fully and purposefully from beginning to end.

Week 3 – Our God Who Restores What Sin Has Broken

- **Genesis 3** – Sin breaks God’s good design, creating the need for restoration.
- **Matthew 3** – Repentance prepares the way for spiritual renewal.
- **Ezra 3** – Worship is restored even before everything is rebuilt.
- **Acts 3** – God restores lives through repentance and healing in Christ.
- **Psalm 51** – God restores broken hearts through repentance and mercy.

Week 4 – Our God Who Triumphs Over Evil

- **Genesis 4** – Sin spreads, yet God continues His redemptive plan.
- **Matthew 4** – Jesus resists temptation, showing obedience over evil.
- **Ezra 4** – God’s work faces opposition but is not defeated.
- **Acts 4** – Persecution cannot stop the advance of the gospel.
- **Psalm 2** – God reigns sovereignly despite rebellion against Him.

Week 5 – Our God Who Is Building His Kingdom

- **Genesis 5** – God's promise continues faithfully through obedient generations.
- **Matthew 5** – Jesus teaches what kingdom obedience looks like from the heart.
- **Ezra 5** – God's work advances when His people obey despite resistance.
- **Acts 5** – Obedience to God matters more than approval from people.
- **Psalm 127** – God alone establishes lasting work and fruit.

Week 6 – Our God Who Sees Us

- **Genesis 6** – God sees the condition of human hearts, not just outward behavior.
- **Matthew 6** – God values hidden righteousness over public recognition.
- **Ezra 6** – God fulfills His unseen plans through His sovereign word.
- **Acts 6** – God honors faithful service that often goes unnoticed.
- **Psalm 33** – God sees every heart and plan on the earth.

Week 7 – Our God Who Is Always Faithful

- **Genesis 7** – God protects His people even through judgment and chaos.
- **Matthew 7** – Obedience provides a firm foundation in storms.
- **Nehemiah 1** – God hears His people's prayers in moments of distress.
- **Acts 7** – God remains faithful even when His servants suffer.
- **Psalm 46** – God is a refuge and strength in times of trouble.

Week 8 – Our God Who Remembers Us

- **Genesis 8** – God remembers Noah and faithfully brings deliverance after the flood.
- **Matthew 8** – Jesus shows God's care by noticing and responding to the forgotten and hurting.
- **Nehemiah 2** – God remembers His people and provides help through unexpected favor.
- **Acts 8** – God remembers individuals by personally bringing the gospel to them.
- **Psalm 8** – God is mindful of humanity and honors us with His care

Week 9 – Our God Who Forgives Our Sins

- **Genesis 9** – God renews covenant relationship after failure.
- **Matthew 9** – Jesus forgives sins and restores the broken.
- **Nehemiah 3** – God rebuilds His people together despite past sin.
- **Acts 9** – God transforms a persecutor into a servant of grace.
- **Psalm 32** – Forgiveness brings freedom and joy.

Week 10 – Our God Who Unites Us

- **Genesis 10** – God forms nations from one human family.
- **Matthew 10** – Jesus sends His followers out together in mission.
- **Nehemiah 4** – God strengthens unity during opposition.
- **Acts 10** – God unites Jews and Gentiles into one people.
- **Psalm 133** – Unity among God's people is a blessing from Him.

Week 11 – Our God Who Is Abundantly Merciful

- **Genesis 11** – Pride leads to division, but God humbles humanity.
- **Matthew 11** – Jesus offers rest and mercy to the humble and weary.
- **Nehemiah 5** – God calls His people to show mercy and justice.
- **Acts 11** – God extends mercy beyond cultural boundaries.
- **Psalm 103** – God's mercy is abundant and compassionate.

Week 12 – Our God Who Overcomes Our Fears

- **Genesis 12** – God calls Abram to trust Him despite uncertainty.
- **Matthew 12** – Faith in Jesus is challenged by opposition.
- **Nehemiah 6** – God protects His work despite intimidation.
- **Acts 12** – God delivers His people when danger is greatest.
- **Psalm 56** – Faith grows stronger in the presence of fear.

Week 13 – Our God Who Calls Us To His Work

- **Genesis 13** – God directs His servants in faithful obedience.
- **Matthew 13** – God’s kingdom grows through faithful response.
- **Nehemiah 7** – God organizes His people for service.
- **Acts 13** – God sends His church on mission.
- **Psalm 96** – God calls His people to proclaim His glory.

Week 14 – Our God Who Is Always Working

- **Genesis 14** – God works through unexpected events to protect and bless His people.
- **Matthew 14** – God works beyond human limitations through faith and obedience.
- **Nehemiah 8** – God works through His Word to bring renewal and understanding.
- **Acts 14** – God continues His work through perseverance despite hardship and opposition.
- **Psalm 73** – God is at work even when His purposes are not immediately clear.

Week 15 – Our God Who Is Our Great Reward

- **Genesis 15** – God promises Himself as Abram’s reward.
- **Matthew 15** – True faith values God over tradition.
- **Nehemiah 9** – God’s people worship Him as faithful and sufficient.
- **Acts 15** – God preserves grace over legalism.
- **Psalm 16** – God is our portion and joy.

Week 16 – Our God Who Cares For Us

- **Genesis 16** – God sees and cares for the overlooked.
- **Matthew 16** – God reveals truth personally to His followers.
- **Nehemiah 10** – God leads His people into committed obedience.
- **Acts 16** – God guides His servants step by step.
- **Psalm 34** – God sees, hears, and delivers His people.
