SURGE: Greater Things!

“Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that believeth on me, the works that I do shall he do also; and greater works than these shall he do ...” (John 14:12).

In 2026, let’s attest more than ever that “Our God is greater!” Join with us in our weekly focus prayer and fasting for the January “30 Days of Prayer,” believing that “greater things are yet to come!” Prayer is the greater work that helps us to achieve greater works in Christ as we communicate with (pray) and serve Him fully.

Jesus refers to “greater works” as the extended work of the Holy Spirit dwelling in us and empowering us for His divine purpose. As His representatives on earth, Jesus has enabled us to spread the gospel and to operate in the supernatural (Matthew 28:18-20; Acts 1:5, 8; 19:11-12; Ephesians 3:20-21). We can do greater works through Him because the ministry of the Spirit is not limited to one person (Jesus) or to one nation (Israel) now. The power comes from Jesus ... and as He works in us and through us, we can “turn the world upside down” (Acts 17:6)!



World Needs

- Pray for America and military members as an Iranian Revolutionary Guard commander indicates the regime has a ‘finger on the trigger’ as American warships head to the Middle East amid anti-regime protests.
- Pray for Sudan as the civil war has killed approximately 150,000 people and displaced 13 million people. Also pray for Christians who face daily terror as it is believed Government forces allegedly killed 11 Christians.
- Pray for North America and all who lost a loved one and power in the Winter storm as 19,000 flights were cancelled. Around 90 million people are under an extreme cold watch warning, and at least 11 people died and over 800,000 people are still without power.
- Pray for all who lost a loved one in a second rail disaster after a retaining wall fell onto the train tracks near Barcelona, causing the death of the driver and injuring 37 people.
- Pray for the Lord to address issues with shark attacks in Australia as four attacks have triggered warnings to stay out of the water.
- Pray for all who were injured in a massive pileup in snowy Michigan, causing a 100-plus vehicle pileup.
- Continue to pray for peace in Russia/Ukraine war as the first trilateral talks since 2022 are to be held with U.S., Russia, and Ukraine.
- Continue to pray for the peace of Israel, missionaries in Israel, and all countries impacted by the war. Pray also for the defeat of Israel's enemies, according to God's will, and for all deceased hostages to be returned to Israel. Intercede for Gaza to be fully restored to Israel as Israel has joined President Trump's Board of Peace.





PRAYER FOCUS

Worship is not just something we do, or mere words we speak; it's a way of living that shows we value and love the Lord above all else. Scripture teaches that God doesn't need anything; He is sufficient by Himself. Yet He invites us to have a relationship with Him – to share thoughts, likes and dislikes, dreams, and desires with someone who will take the time to respond in return. When you truly love someone, you don't have to be forced to be with them. Rather, you look for ways to share what you feel because true love can't be suppressed.
