Getting Started: Read this week's passage out loud & pray the Holy Spirit will help you understand.

Ice Breaker: How may the American church have become complacent? Is it? Yes or No.

1) What does it mean to have a reputation for being alive but actually be "dead"?

2) How do the promises made to the "overcomers" in this passage encourage you to remain faithful?

3) How can you distinguish between the outward appearance of faith and being truly alive spiritually?

4) If you feel comfortable enough, share how the message to the church in Sardis resonates with your current spiritual state.

5) How does the warning to Sardis reflect the danger of relying on past successes or a good reputation?

6) What are the marks of a living church? What are the marks of a "dead" church or a church living on its reputation?

7) What are some ways that one could "overcome" and receive the promises mentioned?

8) Was there anything you wanted to ask or say to the group this week?

9) Was there anything specific you think God wanted you to take away or change from this passage?

10) How can we pray for you in regard to what we studied this week? Other prayer requests are fine, but we are also looking for a specific prayer request for you in regard to this week's passage.
