Ice Breaker: How may the American church have become complacent? Is it? Yes or No.

- 1) What does it mean to have a reputation for being alive but actually be "dead"?

- 2) How do the promises made to the "overcomers" in this passage encourage you to remain faithful?

- 3) How can you distinguish between the outward appearance of faith and being truly alive spiritually?

- 4) If you feel comfortable enough, share how the message to the church in Sardis resonates with your current spiritual state.

- 5) How does the warning to Sardis reflect the danger of relying on past successes or a good reputation?

- 6) What are the marks of a living church? What are the marks of a "dead" church or a church living on its reputation?

- 7) What are some ways that one could "overcome" and receive the promises mentioned?

- 8) Was there anything you wanted to ask or say to the group this week?

- 9) Was there anything specific you think God wanted you to take away or change from this passage?

- 10) How can we pray for you in regard to what we studied this week? Other prayer requests are fine, but we are also looking for a specific prayer request for you in regard to this week's passage.
