Fruit of the Spirit—Love

"But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, forbearance, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control. Against such things there is no law." (Galatians 5:22-23)

Love conquers all. Love wins. But first, love. All of these sayings have circulated in culture over the past couple of years, emphasizing the definition of love and its primacy. But what's the importance of love?

Well, this is when we can turn to Scripture. Most of us can jump to the passage that is read at almost any wedding. *"Love is patient, love is kind. It does not envy, it does not boast. It is not proud. It is not rude. It is not self-seeking, it is not easily angered, it keeps no record of wrongs. Love does not delight in evil but rejoices in truth. It always protects, always trusts, always hopes, always perseveres. Love never fails. But where there are prophecies, they will cease; where there are tongues, they will be stilled; where there is knowledge it will pass away."* (1 Corinthians 13:4-8).

It is a very quotable verse, and it is printed on so much home decor that it is almost a guarantee to see this sign at any home. But what about the rest of what Scripture says? *"Love binds us in perfect unity."* (Colossians 3:14). *"Love covers all wrongs."* (Proverbs 10:12). *"Whoever does not love does not know God, because God is love."* (1 John 4:8). God is love.

1 John 4:19 states that we love because He first loved us. Do you understand that? We are able to recognize love because God granted us that ability. Our love has no real meaning unless God is part of it because God is love. God and love exist together in perfect harmony. God is love. To truly know love is to understand a part of God's character.

We can love others and God because He first loved us. To connect with the theme of these devotionals, Fruit of the Spirit, we understand that love

is a fruit that flows from God's Spirit within us. So when we go out and love our neighbors, we recognize that our ability to love comes from God's love for us, and that it is His Spirit flowing through us when we love.

Love does not delight in evil but rejoices with the truth.
(1 Corinthians 13:6)



TRUE LOVE

A guy dates a girl for three months. She says she's in love. He's not sure, but he knows he feels different when he's with her. He wonders if that's love. Maybe you've wondered too.

Want to know if you feel genuine love? Ask yourself this: *Do I encourage this person to do what is right?* For true love "takes no pleasure in other people's sins but delights in the truth" (1 Corinthians 13:6).





Here's an example. A young couple is on a date. His affection goes beyond her comfort zone. She resists. He tries the oldest line in the book: "But I love you. I just want to be near you. If you loved me . . ." That siren you hear? It's the phony-love detector. This guy doesn't love her. True love will never ask the "beloved" to do what he or she thinks is wrong.

Want to know if your love for someone is true? If your friendship is genuine? Ask if you influence this person to do what is right. If you answer yes, ask her out for lunch.

Love has inspired more songs, books, movies, and bad poetry than any emotion you can think of. But what exactly is it? You'll find no better definition than Paul's words in 1 Corinthians 13. Check it out. I think you'll love it.
