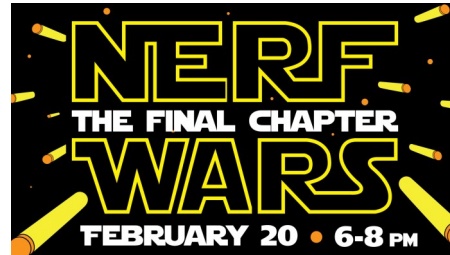

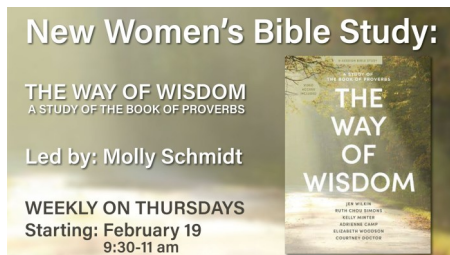

Detox Your Mind and Reclaim What Matters Most

Message: GUARDING YOUR FAMILY FROM DIGITAL DANGER February 15, 2026

Text: Nehemiah 4:13-14

BIG IDEA | ASSESS AND STRENGTHEN THE GATES OF YOUR HOME

"The Jews who lived near the enemy came and told us again and again, 'They will come from all directions and attack us!' So I placed armed guards behind the lowest parts of the wall in the exposed areas. I stationed the people to stand guard by families, armed with swords, spears, and bows. Then as I looked over the situation, I called together the nobles and the rest of the people and said to them, 'Don't be afraid of the enemy! Remember the Lord, who is great and glorious, and fight for your brothers, your sons, your daughters, your wives, and your homes!'"

Nehemiah 4:12-14

GETTING STARTED

What is the strangest or funniest rule your family had in place when you were growing up?

REFLECTION/DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. How does Nehemiah encourage the people to persist in the task? What does he want them to remember (v.14)?
2. What happens when the Jews return to work? How was the plot of their enemies foiled?
3. Nehemiah was responding to the internal fears of the people. What aspects of modern technology are scaring you today for your kids or grandkids?
4. Talk about a time when you were protected from something because of a barrier that was put in place.
5. What barriers do you currently have to guard your life from the dangers of technology? Are there places that need to be strengthened?
6. Talk as a family or group about practical ways you will assess and strengthen the gates to your devices. What impact might this have on your family or group one year from today?
7. What are the prayer requests on your mind and heart today?

PRAYER: Lord Jesus, we are so grateful that you are strong when we are weak. Thank you for giving us the tools to fight against our worldly desires. Help us to be gatekeepers for our families and those that we love. May we assess what comes into our homes and what goes out. In the name of Christ, we pray, Amen.

GOING DEEPER: Read Nehemiah 4:1-23. Why do you think Sanballat was so opposed to Nehemiah's efforts? How effective were his taunts in slowing down the building project? What would a strong city of Jerusalem represent? Which gives you more difficulty: external criticism or internal fears? Why? How can you strengthen the gates of your heart?
