Rejoice in the Lord always; again I will say, rejoice. Let your reasonableness be known to everyone. 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DAILY DEVOTION

A FOCUS ON PRAYER AND PEACE

If we look at the previous pages with the direction of Paul - via the Holy Spirit in the inspired Word of God - then we see a God of order and purpose.

Paul tells us plainly how to receive peace from God to **guard our hearts and minds**, and how to have **the God of peace be with us**.

Here is what we are to do as believers: **do not be anxious about anything** (I know, easier said than done), **but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God**.

Prayer: Well, prayer is a gimme for this devotional. On one of the following pages, you will see the Lord's Prayer. It's how Jesus taught His disciples to pray. Pray this prayer each day to start your devotion time.

Supplication: This simply means that you know what you want from God, and you make it **clearly** known to Him. You can even list it out (which is recommended).

Thanksgiving: Tell God why you Love Him and what you are thankful for in your life. Try this next: focus on the things that you have received that once you may have only hoped for. These things are often forgotten and given little attention.

A FOCUS ON PRAYER AND PEACE

Notice Paul never mentions a yes or no answer to your prayers.

Read: 2 Thessalonians 3:16

Now may the Lord of peace himself give you peace at all times in every way. The Lord be with you all.

Read: Ephesians 2:14-17

For he himself is our peace, who has made us both one and has broken down in his flesh the dividing wall of hostility by abolishing the law of commandments expressed in ordinances, that he might create in himself one new man in place of the two, so making peace, and might reconcile us both to God in one body through the cross, thereby killing the hostility. And he came and preached peace to you who were far off and peace to those who were near.

Prayer: "Our Father in heaven, hallowed be your name. Your kingdom come, your will be done, on earth as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread, and forgive us our debts, as we also have forgiven our debtors. And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil.

Read: John 14:26-27

But the Helper, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, he will teach you all things and bring to your remembrance all that I have said to you.
