THE NAME ABOVE EVERY NAME

PHILIPPIANS 2:9-11

Explore the Heart of Christ

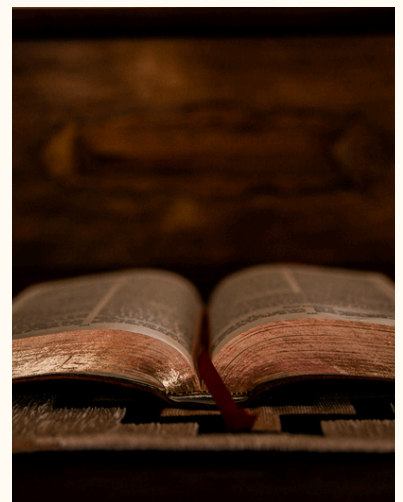
Philippians 2:9-11 follows immediately after Paul's description of Christ's humiliation and death on the cross, presenting God's glorious response to Jesus' obedient submission. Written by Paul from prison as part of his letter to the church at Philippi, this passage reveals the ultimate exaltation that followed Jesus' ultimate humiliation. Jesus became the greatest example of a humble servant, through coming to earth in humility, living in obedience, and dying on the cross. As a result, "God has highly exalted him." The word "therefore" connects Christ's exaltation directly to His willingness to humble Himself. God bestowed upon Jesus "the name that is above every name" - a reference to the name "Lord" (Yahweh), which declares His supreme authority over all creation. When Paul said, "At the name of Jesus every knee will bow—in heaven and on earth and under the earth," the emphasis was on every creature in the universe acknowledging Jesus as Lord over all creation.

In Philippians 2:9-11 we read that Jesus has the name above all names: "Therefore God exalted him to the highest place and gave him the name that is above every name, that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, in heaven and on earth and under the earth, and every tongue acknowledge that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father." What did Paul mean when he said that God gave Jesus the name that is above every name?

What Is Lent and Why Does It Matter?

Lent is a sacred season in the Christian calendar that begins on Ash Wednesday and lasts for 40 days leading up to Easter Sunday. The 40 days are a reflection of the time Jesus spent fasting and praying in the wilderness before beginning His ministry. It is a period set aside for prayer, fasting, and reflection as we prepare our hearts to celebrate the resurrection of Jesus Christ. Throughout history, Christians around the world have observed this season as a time to slow down, draw closer to God, and examine their faith more deeply.

But Lent is about more than just giving something up – it is an invitation to grow. It is a time to let go of the things that distract us from God and to fill that space with prayer, scripture, and acts of service and generosity. Whether you choose to fast from certain foods, set aside extra time for devotion, or take on a new spiritual practice, the goal of Lent is the same – to arrive at Easter with a renewed heart and a deeper appreciation for the incredible sacrifice and victory of Jesus Christ. We encourage you to use this season intentionally and allow it to be a transformative time in your walk with the Lord.
