GET IN THE GAME: ACTIVATE CHURCH PARTICIPATION MATTHEW 28:16-20

Power of Community

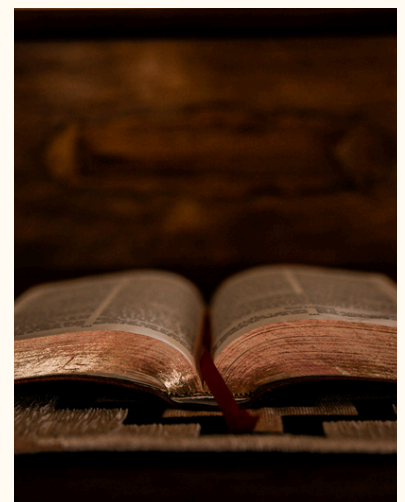
Matthew 28:16-20 contains what is commonly known as the Great Commission, Jesus' final instructions to His disciples before His ascension. Written by Matthew as the climactic conclusion to his Gospel, this passage occurs on a mountain in Galilee where Jesus had appointed to meet His eleven remaining disciples after His resurrection. In Christianity, the Great Commission is the instruction of the resurrected Jesus Christ to his disciples to spread the gospel to all the nations of the world, though interestingly Matthew notes that even in this moment "some doubted." Jesus' instructions result from the authority he possesses. Because of this, it is fitting to reflect on this passage on Holy Trinity Sunday, as it contains the first explicit Trinitarian baptismal formula. Jesus begins by declaring that all authority in heaven and earth has been given to Him, establishing His divine right to commission His followers.

Commentary on Matthew 28:16-20

Readers today often interpret this passage as a directive to evangelize others. After all, the imperative verb is right there: "make disciples of all nations..." (28:19). Although Jesus uses the formula "Father and Son and Holy Spirit," Trinitarian theology as we know it took many centuries to develop. Reading it backward into this first century Gospel may not be appropriate.

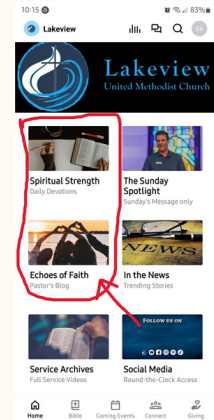
Vendor setup runs 7:00–9:00 a.m. Tables are available for \$30 each. To reserve your spot, call the church office and leave your name and phone number.
