## Leviticus 12: Life with God in a Fallen World

### I. The First Anchor: God \_\_\_\_\_ (v. 1)

- "The LORD spoke to Moses."
- This is divine \_\_\_\_\_, not human guesswork.
- God defines holiness and provides a way back.
- \_\_\_\_\_ is present before explanation.

### II. The Meaning of "Unclean" (v. 2)

- Unclean ≠ \_\_\_\_\_.
- Unclean describes fitness for sacred space.
- Unclean is related to sin, but it relates to sin differently than moral \_\_\_\_\_.

### III. Three Ways Sin Affects Us

- Guilt: sins we \_\_\_\_\_.
- Wounds: sins done \_\_\_\_\_ us.
- Creation Groaning: impersonal effects of a broken creation.
- Purity rituals in Leviticus often deal with this third category: living in a \_\_\_\_\_ world.

### IV. Why Childbirth Involves Uncleaness
