## Short-Term Mission Trip Plans for 2026

### Budapest, Hungary

Budapest is a beautiful, multi-cultural city where most people you encounter will speak English. These trips are all new for our church.



#### Summer/Fall 2026. Estimated Cost \$3000

This is **for adults** who wish to host Hungarian Pastors in a Retreat setting. These men are all co-vocational and seldom have any time off for rest. Coming out of extreme restrictions during the Covid Pandemic, they were thrust into Ukrainian refugee relief when Russia invaded nearby Ukraine. Details are few at this early stage. This trip is open to any adults. People with counseling credentials, however, are especially needed.

#### Holiday Season, late Nov/early Dec. Estimated Cost \$3000

This ministry will revolve around the Christmas Market season (mid-November to mid-December) in Europe. One team will **consist of singers (audition required)** who will sing Christmas Carols (think low key flash mob) each evening at Budapest's Christmas Market while local church members engage those who stop to listen with the Gospel. Another team will work during the day with a yet to be determined project. This could possibly be with IMB's ministry to the Roma people (nomadic Indo-Aryan) outside of Budapest or sharing the gospel on the streets of Budapest with locals and tourists.

## Short-Term Mission Trip Plans for 2026

### Kenya

**July 7 – 17. Estimated Cost: \$3000**

Since 2008 we have partnered with The 410 Bridge in Kenya. For a dozen years we served the community of Endana, a very poor, rural area north of Nairobi near the equator in an area generally called Segera. Endana graduated from The 410 Bridge Model in 2020. Building on the foundation laid by previous trips, the 2026 team will work alongside the people of our new community partner, Mutirithia.



This year's project will include interaction with school children, visits in villagers' homes as well as their churches. In addition, the 410 Bridge has been very successful helping many locals establish small businesses through a basic training program. Travelers will get to meet some of these business owners and see how 410 Bridge is helping to establish a solid economic foundation for local residents.

### Bulgaria

**June 22 – July 3. Estimated Cost: \$2500**

Each summer we work with our church partners in Holy Trinity Christian Church Sophia, Bulgaria, and Pastor Grozdan Stoevski to help administer **a camp for families of special needs children**. This camp has had a huge impact on the communities around Smolyan, Bulgaria.



Leading up to the camp we conduct In Service Training in a few schools for teachers working with children with special needs. This trip also makes an impact on travelers from BPF as they get to build relationships with families with similar struggles in a very different, very beautiful part of Eastern Europe. **We primarily, but not exclusively need team members such as therapists or teachers who have direct experience with special needs children or relatives with special needs family members.** Others who have exposure in this area are encouraged to fill out the application.

### Bolivia

**July 11 – 19. Estimated Cost: \$3000**

Brazos Pointe Fellowship first sent a short-term mission team to Santa Cruz, Bolivia in 2008. Since then, BPF has sent at least one team almost every year. We are connected with multiple partners through Kairos Church in Santa Cruz, Bolivia.



Our 2026 trip will focus on working with one partner, Gracia ministry in Santa Cruz. Information on all of our Bolivian partners can be seen below:

### Seattle, Washington

**Tentative: July 11 – 18. Estimated Cost: \$1100**

BPF has been sponsoring the work of The Mountain Church since it was planted seven years ago. Even though the Seattle area is generally not open to the gospel, The Mountain Church is breaking through cultural barriers and successfully reaching people in the area south of Seattle.



Our team will be serving alongside Mountain Church members to help lead a Vacation Bible School in the neighborhood of Federal Way, just outside of Seattle. We get to build relationships in the community and make more people aware of The Mountain Church. This trip provides an opportunity to see how church planting carries the Good News of Jesus to people who have never heard the Gospel.

### Southeast Asia

#### DIY Trips Available for Small Teams – Estimated Cost: \$3000

Our ministry in a “closed country” in Southeast Asia is built around a partnership with missionaries from our own church that uses sports camps, ESL Classes (English as a Second Language), and expanding business opportunities for the locals to form and build relationships.



- The local schools are very receptive to having our teams come in and work with students on their English skills which helps establish community relationships.
- Sports opportunities include offering sports camps for basketball and soccer or private golf lessons.
- A new opportunity is now available to engage with coffee growers. Coffee is a large product in the plateau region near our partner’s location. Engagement with these growers and processors helps develop relationships with a group of people with whom our partners would otherwise have no connection. This team would help with the coffee harvest (November to January) to promote communications with the local community.

Through immersive, gospel-centered community life and real ministry engagement, students learn what it means to love people, serve alongside church planters, and make disciples wherever God calls them.
