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## DAY 2: BEST GIFT EVER

### Read John 3:16

What is the best gift you've ever received? Is it something you asked for or something that came as a total surprise? Think back to the moment when you opened the package. What did you do?

God loved us. And so He did what people who love do, He gave. But His gift wasn't something you could wrap up in paper and ribbons. God sent Jesus to the Earth to make a way for us to have a relationship with Him forever.

**Grab a piece of paper and write out the words of this verse in big block or bubble letters. Inside each of the following words, draw a different design inside each letter: loved, gave, Son, anyone, believes, eternal life. Hold onto this as you will add to it this week.**

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## DAY 3: EVERYWHERE, ALL AT ONCE

### Read 1 John 4:7

Where does love come from? Love comes from God. In fact, you only know how to love because God first loved you. Before anyone in your life, God loved you first. Love was God's idea. It's who He is. It's what He does.

God's love for you isn't based on what you do or don't do. It's a "just because" kind of love. You don't have to earn it. You don't have to perform or act a certain way to receive it. And He proved His love by sending Jesus. He paid the price of our sin by dying on the cross and rising again on the third day to make a way for us to have a relationship with God forever. What a good, good God.

**Grab your paper from yesterday. Somewhere on the page draw a globe, adding land masses and oceans. Then draw a large heart around the globe as a reminder that God loves the whole world.**

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## DAY 4: LOVE DISPLAYED

### Read 1 John 4:9

God loves you. And He did what people who love do, He gave. Over 2,000 years ago, God sent Jesus into the world as a tiny, helpless baby. That baby grew up. He taught others about God, and He lived a completely perfect, sinless life.

And at the end of His time on earth, He willingly chose to suffer and die on the cross to pay the penalty for your sin.

Because God chose to send Jesus to the world, our sin no longer separates us from God. Isn't that amazing? God loved us first, so we could show His love to others too.

**Grab your picture from yesterday. Draw a cross as a reminder of what Jesus has done for you.**

## DAY 5: THE WHOLE WORLD

## Read 1 John 4:10

God's love for us was proven in one amazing act—sending His only Son to rescue us. Did you know you needed to be rescued? It's true. Our sin separates us from a holy and perfect God. But because God LOVED us, He gave us Jesus. Jesus took the punishment for our sin to rescue us so that we can have a relationship with God forever.

All around the edge of your page, draw stick figures to represent all the people God loves! You can add as much detail as you like. God sent Jesus because He loves the whole world. But there's one other big truth: If you were the only one, Jesus still would have died for you. Pretty awesome, right?

**“Jesus, thank You for loving me so much that You would go all the way to the cross, give Your life, and be raised again so that I can live with You forever. Help me to live my life so that others can see just how much You love me and them. Amen.”**
