ENGAGE IN EVERYDAY MOMENTS TOGETHER



Morning Time

When you go into your child's room, say: "Good morning, [child's name]! I'm thankful Jesus loves us every minute of every day and that nothing will ever make Jesus stop loving us!"



Cuddle Time

Cuddle with your child and pray: "God, [name of child] and I are so thankful that Jesus wants to be our friend forever and nothing will ever, ever, EVER make Jesus stop loving us."



Drive Time

While on the go, take turns naming things you are thankful for (food, family, friends, home, car, clothes, etc.). End by saying that you are thankful Jesus will always love us no matter what.



Bath Time

As you bathe your child, say this together and clap on each word: "One, two, Jesus loves you. (Point at each other on "you.") One, two, three, Jesus loves me!" (Point thumbs to chest on "me.")
