Calvary Chapel Christian Academy Overview

Mission Statement

Our mission is to share in the ministry of Calvary Chapel by offering Christian education from a Biblical worldview, while partnering with parents and guardians who have the God-given responsibility to educate their children. We desire to raise up disciples of Christ by promoting academic, social and spiritual excellence. Equipping students from K to 12th Grades to become a transforming influence on the world for Christ is at the core of a CCCA education (Ephesians 4:12-13).

History

Calvary Chapel Christian Academy was founded as an educational ministry of Calvary Chapel Harrisburg - West Shore. The primary goal was and still is to work with Christian families to educate and disciple godly young men and women. CCCA is accredited with the Association of Christian Teachers and Schools (ACTS). Our academic programs are designed to meet the learning needs of all students. We engage mixed modalities to reach each student's God-given gift for inquisitiveness and love for learning. We serve Jesus's kids!

Diversity and Marriage Statement

Calvary Chapel Christian Academy believes that an individual's first responsibility is to the God of the Bible and that a person's whole life should reflect His framework in a context of peace and selfless love. CCCA asserts that a genuine love for and interaction with diverse peoples is a biblical mandate. Moreover, Calvary Chapel Christian Academy recognizes that we are all one in the body of Christ. Our standard for diversity is found in the Bible.

Individual differences in lifestyle that deny, ignore or reject biblical standards represent diversity in rebellion to God's standards and hence, are unacceptable for the families of CCCA. CCCA holds to the beliefs as stated in the New King James Version of the Bible and asserts that marriage is the union between one man and one woman, and that from the beginning of creation God made humans in two distinct biological sexes: male and female.

Statement of Non-discrimination

It is the commitment of CCCA to provide Christian education for God's children, holy and beloved, according to the faith of God's calling, and the acknowledging of the truth that is after godliness and in that context and for that purpose does not discriminate on the basis of race, color, sex or ethnic background. This policy of non-discrimination is exercised during student admission, hiring of faculty and staff, and all school-administered programs.



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CCCA's Philosophy of Education

CCCA's philosophy of education is based upon a Biblical worldview that has been developed out of a literal interpretation of the Bible, as presented in the New King James Version. It is impossible to disconnect our learning and development from the power and purposes of our Creator God. At the very core of CCCA's worldview and philosophy of education is God's Word. It is the foundation of CCCA's philosophical framework. From the origin of man to ethics and morality, we believe all logic and reasoning is based upon the tenets of Scripture. It is upon this premise that Calvary Chapel Harrisburg – West Shore built and developed Calvary Chapel Christian Academy. The governing bodies of both the school and the church are in full agreement with CCCA's philosophy of education.

CCCA's philosophy of education is based upon our Biblical worldview and not upon the philosophy of man. All truth is God's truth. God's Word is truth according to the Scripture (John 17:17, NKJV) and according to the conviction of the Holy Spirit. As such, CCCA's philosophy of education is defined by our master teacher Himself, Jesus Christ. Teaching should be personal and individual. All methods, instructional practices, activities and assessments will be geared toward allowing the learner to better understand the knowledge of God and be better prepared to serve the Lord through successfully navigating and interacting with the world around them. We are set apart for God by understanding His truth; God must be at the core of all the principles, facts and truths we teach.

CCCA develops the curriculum and programs of the school based upon a Biblical worldview. A Biblical world-view is an assurance that the knowledge gained will be based upon God's truth and not just the correlations made by respected men and women of science, history, mathematics and language. While these respected individuals have made vast contributions to our understanding of the world around us, our understanding is not complete until we filter it through God's Word. Our knowledge of God and His Word should cause us to fear no vain philosophy or body of knowledge. We have real truth in our hearts and in Scripture, and with such knowledge and truth we should be able to disprove the fake and vain philosophies of the world. The better we know the creation, the better we know the Creator. With a strong Biblical worldview, the disciplines of math, science, history and language are but a mere platform for believers to express the goodness of God, the truth of His Word and to praise Him for His many blessings. Psalm 19:1 states, "The heavens declare the glory of God; and the firmament (skies) shows His handiwork" (NKJV).

Non-Academic Special Needs or Severe Learning Disabilities

CCCA is a ministry of Calvary Chapel of Harrisburg - West Shore and has limited resources to educate its students. Due to our limited resources, CCCA may be unable to properly educate students with non-academic special needs or severe learning disabilities. We reserve the right to deny admittance and attendance to students for whom we feel we cannot offer a sound and complete education. This decision may be made at any point during the application, interview, or acceptance process, or during the school year based upon information received.

CRITERIA FOR STUDENT ADMISSION

1. A clear profession of faith in Jesus Christ from at least one parent of the applicant.
2. Regular attendance at a Bible-believing church.
3. Parents understand and commit to the purpose of Calvary Chapel Christian Academy which provides children with a Christ-centered education acknowledging the Lordship of Jesus Christ in every subject taught and every area of living.
4. Parents commit to support the work of the academy through regular prayer and participation in the academy activities.
5. Applicants give every indication of potential success in the academy’s program of academics based on past records, entrance tests, and interviews.
6. Applicants provide past evidence of emotional stability and a satisfactory record of behavior and attendance.

ADMISSION PROCEDURE

1. Submit completed application to church office or via email.
2. Church will forward application to administration when Application Checklist Requirements have been met.
3. Based on CCCA’s Criteria for Student Admission, the administration reviews the application to establish compatibility.
4. Interview with an administrator is scheduled.
5. Interview process includes:
 - a. Declaration of salvation and testimony of child and/or parent(s)
 - b. Church affiliation
 - c. Academic review
 - d. Academic testing (when applicable)
 - e. Disciplinary review
 - f. Get acquainted
6. After the interview process, the administration team prayerfully confirms that the family and student have met the criteria required for acceptance.

IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENTS

Pennsylvania Department of Health School Immunization regulations require that: All pupils must be immunized or exempted before admission to any school in Pennsylvania. Immunization data must be received for all students.

Children may be **registered** without proof of immunizations prior to the start of school. However, in order to **attend** school, written proof of a minimum of at least one dose of each required vaccine is required. This is called a **provisional** admission. When a student is admitted **provisionally**, a plan for completing the immunizations must be submitted by the parent(s)/guardian(s). Provisional records will be reviewed every 60 days. If the plan is not followed, or the provisional period expires before immunizations have been completed, the student may be excluded from school until evidence of immunization or exemption is submitted. All immunizations must be completed within 5 days after the first day the child attended school.

There are two categories of **EXEMPTION** from the immunization requirements:

- Religious exemption** – Students need not be immunized if the parent or guardian objects, in writing, to the immunization on religious grounds or a strong moral or ethical conviction.

- Medical exemption** – Students need not be immunized if a physician or his/her designee states, in writing, that the immunization may be detrimental to the health of the child. This may be either a temporary or permanent status. When the physician determines that the immunization is no longer detrimental to the health of the child, the exemption ceases to be valid and the child must be immunized.

Parents of all exempt students should be aware that if the Pennsylvania Department of Health declares an epidemic of a disease for which immunization is an admission requirement, students who are exempted will not be permitted to attend school for the duration of the epidemic.

Tuition Schedule

Kindergarten – 12th Grade Tuition:

\$250 Registration Fee per Child. Due May 8th with Application Submission. This fee is non-refundable and will be used to process your children's renewal application or new application.

Tuition per child per year: \$6,500 (\$650 per month for 10-month installment plan – August through May).

Fourth Child Discount:

The "Fourth Child Discount" allows the fourth child in a family to attend CCCA tuition FREE.

NOTE: \$250 Registration Fee still required.

Before and After School Programs:

- Before School Program: 7 a.m. to 7:30 a.m. (per child/per day) \$7.00
- After School Program: 3:30 p.m. to 5 p.m. (per child/per day) \$12.00
- Unlimited Monthly Before/After Care (per child/per month) \$235.00

PAYMENT OPTIONS:

1. One payment: 100% tuition is due Thursday, August 1st (5% Discount)
2. Ten monthly payments of \$650 are due August through May between the 1st and the 10th of the month.

ELECTRONIC PAYMENT by credit or debit card:

1. There is a 2% fee on all credit or debit card transactions and/or on-line payments.

MID-YEAR ENTRY:

When a student enters the academy during the year, tuition will be charged for each month the student is registered (regardless of the number of days in attendance the first month) on the basis of 1/10th of the annual tuition. The first payment will also include the \$250 Registration fee.

MISCELLANEOUS:

- No re-registration will be accepted if there is a balance due on the account.
- Registration/Re-registration fee is non-refundable.
- If your child is withdrawn during the course of the school year, you will be charged for the total days that your child was enrolled.
- Your child can be dismissed from CCCA for late/unpaid tuition or fees.
