Study Questions

What did this message tell you about God?

What did this message tell you about people?

We talked about the fact that Biblical faith isn't blind, it's based on good theology. The starting point of good theology is understanding the gospel (good news) of Jesus. What can you learn from the sinless humanity of Jesus that kept him faithful to the will of the father, even though it was very hard. See Matthew 26:36-39 and Hebrews 12:1-3. What good theology do you know that helps you endure difficult circumstances?

We talked about the fact that Biblical faith always involves action, it's not just that we know stuff about Jesus. Look at Jude 1:3. What do you think Jude means by "contend" for the faith. Now pivot to Hebrews 11. Go through the list of people who "contended" for the faith. List the thing that they did that got them remembered for it. What are you doing for Jesus that people will remember you for?

Having doubts and bad days while being loyal to Jesus is normal. It is not apostasy. Share with each other ways that you sometimes struggle in your faith, maybe even the doubts you have, and support one another in prayer and encouragement.
