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

WHO WE ARE...

Crossroads Community is a faith family that partners with other believers to demonstrate the compassion of Jesus to our community. God provides a variety of opportunities to meet physical needs, but the ultimate goal of mission partnership is sharing the gospel. God continues to allow us to work together as one body with many churches.

Our faith family might be small in number, but God empowers us to glorify Him through various ministries and partnerships. We are excited to welcome mission teams and individuals to come along side us to fulfill His calling. God has placed us in one of the poorest areas of the country to demonstrate His compassion by meeting physical needs. However, we know the greatest need for all is to be reconciled to God. Sharing the gospel is at the core of everything we do.

Our county is located in the heart of the Daniel Boone National Forest. McCreary County is known for its scenic beauty with forests, waterfalls, and natural arches. Through many different issues in the county's history, an impoverished lifestyle has become a part of life for many. Over fifty-one percent of our residents live on government assistance; most social economic statistics ranks McCreary County as the poorest county in the country.

THE LIGHT COMMUNITY

The Light Community is a working tiny home farm. We are welcoming our first residence as we continue to complete additional tiny homes. We welcome individuals and families that need a safe place to live and grow. Our focus is on Biblical counseling, financial stewardship, and basic life-skills.

God has blessed us with mission teams and skill workers to complete the homes. Three homes are requiring one more inspection to be complete and open! God has recently blessed us with partnerships with both a Kentucky electrician and plumber.

Tiny homes and other community areas are currently in the plans to be added to the farm. Three homes are one inspection from opening! Three more are being completed now. We need teams work to finish homes that are nearing completion as well as for three more ground up construction of homes. We are also seeking teams to build a barn and other community areas such as walking trials, playground, and outdoor picnic area.

Mission team can be involved at The Light Community through several possibilities. In addition to hands opportunity for construction and farm jobs, we encourage mission teams to build relationships with the residence that will be living at The Light Community. This ministry will continue to grow and develop



Construction projects for the coming months:

- Drywall – hanging to finishing
- Painting – interior walls and ceilings; porches
- Tile work – backer board, moister barrier, and tile laying
- Some plumbing and electrical (must prearrange this skill set)
- Drainage – help with runoff from hill sides on two sides of the property
- Ground up construction of new tiny homes
- Ground up construction of barn
- Repair pier support on one of the tiny homes


House #1

Two bedroom home - this home need a foundation pier repaired before interior work can continue. Once the foundation is repaired, electrical and plumbing rough in must be done then the interior needs to be complete.



House #3

The loft house is scheduled for electrical and plumbing rough spring '26. Once these two are complete, all the interior finishings will need to done. Our goal is to have this home ready by the end of summer '26.



House #4

The Laundry House - The front of the laundry house will have four sets of washers and dryers. The flooring is complete, we have the metal for the walls, and two sets of washers and dryers have been donated. A hot water heater is also needed. We need the rough in electric and plumbing completed (on the radar by spring '26). The rear of the building is used for storage. Countertops and shelving need to be added.

Loft home needing the final plumbing inspection to be complete.




House #6

Once rough in inspections are complete, all ceilings, walls, and floors will need to be added. The kitchen and bathroom will also need to be finished from stud walls to complete.




House #10




Cabin Addition







The picture example on this page is a dream of what we would like to have. Gravel, post with string lights, stone fire pit, and seating.




Covered Shelter with Dining and Grilling Area






What to Expect..



Teams are encouraged to bring clean, presorted clothing to giveaway during there time here. This is always a great need! We have two large tents and tables available. 2-5 volunteers


