## 2 - 3 Years

### TOPIC

Simon and His Boat (Part 1)

### QUESTIONS

- What happened the first time Simon went fishing?
- What did Jesus do from Simon's boat?
- What happened the second time Simon went fishing?

### BIG IDEA

Jesus reveals he has God's power and authority and calls the disciples to follow him.

# 4 - 5 Years

## TOPIC

Jesus Proclaims the Good News (Luke 4:14-21)

## QUESTION

- I wonder who the people thought Jesus was?
- I wonder If you know why Jesus came? (to love us and call us to follow Him. He came to set us free from our sin.)

## BIG IDEA

Good news! Jesus is the Savior sent to free us from sin.

# K - 2nd Grade

## TOPIC

Jesus and the Paralytic (Luke 5:17-25)

## MEMORY VERSE

"Jesus said, 'My sheep hear my voice, and I know them, and they follow me.'" **John 10:27**

## QUESTIONS

- I wonder how the paralytic's friends had heard about Jesus?
- I wonder if they were surprised when Jesus forgave his sins instead of healing his body?
- I wonder how the paralyzed man felt when he left the house walking AND forgiven?

## BIG IDEA

Jesus demonstrates his authority to forgive sin.

# 3rd - 5th Grade

## QUESTION

How does God show himself to us?

## ANSWER

Through creation, his word, his family, and Jesus our Savior.

## VERSE

God did this so that they would seek him and perhaps reach out for him and find him, though he is not far from any one of us. For in him we live and move and have our being.

**Acts 17:27-28**

## BIG IDEA

- God is our example of a perfect family through the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit
- The Father wants the whole world to be a part of his family.
