2 - 3 Years

TOPIC

Simon and His Boat (Part 2)

QUESTIONS

- What happened the first time Simon went fishing?
- What did Jesus do from Simon's boat?
- What happened the second time Simon went fishing?

BIG IDEA

Jesus reveals he has God's power and authority and calls the disciples to follow him.

4 - 5 Years

TOPIC

Jesus Calls His Disciples (Luke 5:1-11)

MEMORY VERSE

"My sheep hear my voice; I know them,
and they follow me. **John 10:27**

QUESTION

- Simon had already been fishing all night long! I wonder why he tried again when Jesus asked him to?
- I wonder how Simon felt when he saw all those fish?
- I wonder what Jesus meant when he said that Simon would fish for people now instead of fish?

BIG IDEA

Good news! Jesus is the Savior sent to free us from sin.

K - 2nd Grade

TOPIC

Follow Me - Review (Luke 5)

MEMORY VERSE

"Jesus said, 'My sheep hear my voice, and I know them, and they follow me.'" **John 10:27**

QUESTIONS

- I wonder which of these stories is your favorite?
- I wonder what it was about Jesus that made people want to follow him?
- I wonder what kind of people Jesus is looking for to be part of God's family?

BIG IDEA

Jesus demonstrates his authority to forgive sin.

3rd - 5th Grade

QUESTION

What should we do if we don't feel thankful for Jesus or His church?

ANSWER

We should remember the goodness of God and His salvation for us.

VERSE

"Blessed are those who hunger and thirst for righteousness, for they will be filled."

Matthew 5:6

BIG IDEA

- Going through difficult times can remind us to run to Jesus and our church family.
- God gives us hope when we learn to persevere in love through difficult situations.
