

Session Business
June 30, 2024

1. Administration reported to Session that our new Music Director, Bonnie Hernandez, will take on full responsibilities at the end of July/first part of August.
2. Sunday, July 7, is Stephanie Cooke's last day as FPC's Music Director and there will be a special presentation to her during the service with a reception to follow afterwards.
3. Administration reminded Session that, pursuant to the terms of the loan with PILP, FPC is required to conduct a capital campaign for the purpose of debt reduction, which initially was to be conducted by September 2024. Because FPC does not currently have a permanent pastor, PILP has allowed FPC to extend the timing to next March 2025. For this same reason, Administration believes hiring a capital campaign consultant is the proper avenue to follow and Session approved its recommendation that FPC enter into an agreement with Church Campaign Services for a 12-month period from July 1, 2024, through June 30, 2025, at a fee of \$27,000 with \$9,000 of said fee being payable upon acceptance of this proposal.
