

Session Business
August 18, 2024

1. There was no Stated Session Meeting in July.
2. On July 16 and 17, 2024, via email vote, Session approved the motion submitted by Steve Scheffler, Chair of the PNC, to call a congregational meeting on Sunday, July 28, 2024, during the 11 a.m. worship service for the purpose of presenting its report; and, on July 29 and 30, 2024, via email vote, Session approved the motion submitted by the Administration Committee to pay \$7,000 to Rev. Seth Saathoff for his relocation expenses.
3. Cheryl Nichols, Chair of Administration, talked about the capital campaign, which is required by Presbyterian Investment & Loan Program (PILP) per the terms of FPC's Loan. PILP will re-amortize FPC's loan annually during the three-year campaign. Based upon PILP Calculations, at the end of a 3-year campaign with a goal of \$600,000, FPC can save about \$44,000 annually, which savings can be used toward ministries and operations. The capital campaign, including the preparation phase, will take place over the next few months, and will end in April or May 2025, with a Sunday of offerings, followed up by a report the next month on the offerings received to date.
4. Session approved a motion to replace David Green, the current Administrator of FPC's Raymond James Financial Services Account, with FPC's Church Treasurer, who currently is Fred Kate.
5. Cheryl Nichols reported to Session that the PDS is in the black! She passed out the financials for PDS covering the period of July 1, 2023, through June 30, 2024. The Profit & Loss Statement shows \$573,622.32 in Total Income (which includes the Employee Retention Credit and Grant Income); \$307,657.03 in Total Ordinary Expenses; and \$59,087.12 in Total Grant Expenses, leaving a Net Income of \$193,460.25.
6. The date for September's Session Meeting has been changed to September 22 as the current date for our September session meeting is September 15, the first official Sunday Rev. Seth Saathoff will be in the pulpit.
