John 20:19-31

¹⁹ When it was evening on that day, the first day of the week, and the doors were locked where the disciples were, for fear of the Jews, **Jesus came and stood among them and said, "Peace be with you."** ²⁰ After he said this, he showed them his hands and his side. Then the disciples rejoiced when they saw the Lord. ²¹ Jesus said to them again, **"Peace be with you. As the Father has sent me, so I send you."** ²² When he had said this, he breathed on them and said to them, **"Receive the Holy Spirit."** ²³ If you forgive the sins of any, they are forgiven them; if you retain the sins of any, they are retained."

²⁴ But Thomas (who was called the Twin), one of the twelve, was not with them when Jesus came. ²⁵ **So the other disciples told him, "We have seen the Lord." But he said to them, "Unless I see the mark of the nails in his hands and put my finger in the mark of the nails and my hand in his side, I will not believe."**

²⁶ A week later his disciples were again in the house, and Thomas was with them. Although the doors were shut, Jesus came and stood among them and said, **"Peace be with you."** ²⁷ Then he said to Thomas, **"Put your finger here and see my hands. Reach out your hand and put it in my side. Do not doubt but believe."** ²⁸ Thomas answered him, **"My Lord and my God!"** ²⁹ Jesus said to him, **"Have you believed because you have seen me? Blessed are those who have not seen and yet have come to believe."**

³⁰ Now Jesus did many other signs in the presence of his disciples that are not written in this book. ³¹ But these are written so that you may continue to believe that Jesus is the Messiah, the Son of God, and that through believing you may have life in his name.

Capital Campaign Update

Our FPC Capital Campaign is progressing well, and we are moving quickly to our Celebration Sunday on May 18, 2025! For those of you who have not taken the opportunity to return your commitment cards with your



three-year pledge, we humbly request that you prayerfully complete the pledge card and return it to the church by May 11. We want your contribution to be included in total funds committed to reducing our indebtedness over the next three years! If you think your gift would have little to no impact on our debt reduction, then think again! Consider this:

A \$50/per month commitment equals a total commitment of \$1,800.

What if 10 people/households made the same commitment? That level of giving equals \$18,000!

What if 20 people/households made the same commitment? That level of giving equals \$36,000!

These examples demonstrate the power and impact of the community of faith striving together to expand our capacity of ministry and missions.
