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## Memorize Me

**“Two people are better than one. They can help each other in everything they do.”**

— *Ecclesiastes 4:9*

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## Need to Know

**On God’s Team, Players Show Respect.**

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## Fantastic 5

**Moses and Jethro**

*(Exodus 18)*

1. Moses was leading God's people all by himself, helping them from morning until night.
2. Jethro noticed Moses was tired and cared enough to speak to him kindly.
3. Jethro gave Moses wise advice and encouraged him to get help from other leaders.
4. Moses listened to Jethro and followed his advice instead of trying to do everything alone.
5. When Moses showed respect by listening, everyone was helped and God's team worked better.

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## Ask Me This!

*(Great for the ride home, bedtime, or around the dinner table)*

1. **What was Moses doing all day long?**  
 *Exodus 18:13* — He was helping and leading all the people.
2. **Who noticed Moses was tired and needed help?**  
 *Exodus 18:14* — Jethro.

3. **What advice did Jethro give Moses?**  
 *Exodus 18:17–23* — To share the work and let others help lead.
4. **How did Moses respond to Jethro's advice?**  
 *Exodus 18:24* — He listened and did what Jethro suggested.
5. **What does this story teach us about respect on God's team?**  
 *Exodus 18:24–26* — Showing respect means listening and working together.

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## Take Off!

*(Try this together throughout the week!)*

- **Tuesday:** Read *Exodus 18:13–14* and talk about why it's important to notice when someone needs help.
- **Thursday:** Read *Exodus 18:19–23* and talk about why listening to parents and leaders shows respect.
- **Saturday:** Share a family story about a time listening to wise advice helped things go better.
- **All Week:** Say together:  
**“On God’s team, players show respect!”**

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## Prayer Guide

### On God's Team, Players Show Respect

#### **Opening:**

“Dear God, thank You for putting us on Your team.”

#### **Thanksgiving:**

“Thank You for Jethro’s wisdom and for teaching us how to respect others.”

#### **Confession:**

“Forgive us when we don’t listen or choose to do things our own way.”

#### **Prayer for the Child:**

“God, help [child’s name] listen well and show respect to parents, teachers, and leaders.”

#### **Prayer for Wisdom & Obedience:**

“Holy Spirit, help [child’s name] have a kind heart and willing ears.”

#### **Closing:**

“Thank You for helping us learn and grow together. We love You. In Jesus’ name, Amen.”

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## Parent Challenge

This week, talk with your child about **respect** and how it shows love for others.

Read *Exodus 18* together and point out how both Jethro and Moses showed respect—one by speaking kindly, the other by listening.

Encourage your child to practice respect by listening the first time, speaking kindly, and following instructions.

End the week by praying together and thanking God for the leaders He's placed in your child's life.
