Student's Covenant

As I enter the confirmation program at St. Stephens Lutheran Church & School, I pledge to God, my family, my church family, and myself to...

- **Attend Worship services regularly**, recognizing that "God wants to be worshiped through faith so that we receive from Him those things He promises and offers" (Apology of the Augsburg Confession, Article IV, 49).
- **Work diligently to read every lesson and complete every assignment**, trusting that the Holy Spirit works to increase my faith through my studying of God's Word. (2 Peter 3:18; Hebrews 12:11)
- **Attend every Unit Check-In (unless excused by the Youth Director or a pastor)** fully prepared to discuss the unit and share my completed work, knowing that these check-ins help me to practice talking about my faith. (Hebrews 10:25)
- **Attend Junior High LifeGroup regularly**, knowing the Lord created me to grow in faith and live in relationships with others. (2 Peter 3:18; Proverbs 27:17)
- **Submit a minimum of 8 Sermon Notes throughout the year** because taking sermon notes helps me learn to focus on God's Word. (Acts 2:42; Colossians 3:16)
- **Complete the assigned faith project** to demonstrate my understanding of the subject matter. (Colossians 3:23; 1 Cor. 9:24-25)
- **Honor and respect your parents, leaders, mentors, prayer partners, and fellow students** by refraining from distracting behavior or misusing electronic devices during worship, confirmation study, Unit Check-Ins, and LifeGroup meetings. (Ephesians 6:1-3; Hebrews 13:7)
