Discussion Questions:

1. In 1 Corinthians 1:1-3, how does "the will of God" challenge the way we talk about direction, preferences, and leadership after a difficult season in our church, and what would it look like this week to seek God's will through Scripture, prayer, and humble counsel (Acts 18:9-11, James 1:5, Proverbs 3:5-6)?
2. Paul addresses Corinth first as "the church of God". It is good to love your pastors and to honor them, but what does it look like for a congregation to stay God centered, remembering that the Lord is the one who wills, ordains, and sustains His church? How do Matthew 16:18 and 1 Corinthians 3:5-7 shape the way we think about leadership, unity, and growth without making any one person the foundation?
3. Why does Paul remind the Corinthians that they belong with "all who in every place call on the name of Jesus Christ" (Verse 2)? Why does God want us to remember our brothers and sisters outside these church walls?
4. How does the grace of God transform us and make us new? How does peace WITH God, become the foundation for the peace OF God among us that protects unity and pushes back division (Romans 5:1, 2 Corinthians 5:17, Hebrews 12:14)?
