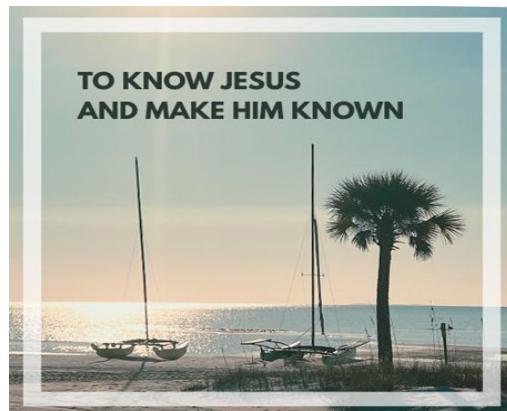
# The Messenger
