Attached is a pamphlet providing information on the Forsyth County Health Department International Travel Clinic. It gives generalized information on International Travel.

Travel to Ghana requires a Yellow Fever Vaccine prior to your trip. Typhoid Fever vaccine is also recommended. Other routine vaccines such as Hepatitis A & B, Polio, Mumps, Measles & Rubella, Tetanus should be current. (Most students will be up to date on these routine vaccines.)

Pricing for Travel Vaccines are:

Yellow Fever Vaccine - \$240

Typhoid Vaccine - \$179

All routine vaccines will be filed with your private insurance provided there is vaccine coverage.

Consultation Fee of \$60.00 per person is due at time of visit.

- You will receive a pre-travel consultation using the most current Centers of Disease Control and World Health Organization recommendations as well as online resources on every country included in your itinerary.
- You will be provided a customized, informative report related to your destination, including required immunizations and information related to environmental and socio-political issues, and unique laws and customs, and contact information for U.S. embassies.
- We will call in to your pharmacy prescriptions for malaria, traveler's diarrhea and altitude prevention if they are determined necessary for your trip.
- A detailed receipt will be provided for submission to your insurance for possible reimbursement.
