From Your Interim Pastor

Over the past few weeks, I've shared eight tips for interpreting scriptures well. Here's the final tip: Test your conclusions through conversation with other serious students of the text.

Our working interpretations are best evaluated in the context of a faith community. Ideally, our faith community provides a host of "safe places" in which to hold such conversations. Bible study classes, the deacon body, age-based ministry groups, and such may offer such opportunities.

Don't be afraid to test your conclusions in dialogue with Christian writers from various branches of Christianity. Christ followers from the Baptist, Anglican, Roman Catholic, Eastern Orthodox, Presbyterian, Methodist, and other traditions have helped me sharpen, revise, or rethink my interpretations. Perhaps the same might prove true for you.

On a different note, we enter the season of Lent this week. Lent calls us to reflect on the state of our relationship with Christ and others, decide what needs to be changed, and set about making such changes. I look forward to sharing the Lenten journey with you.
