

From Your Interim Pastor

I've shared six tips for interpreting the Scriptures well. Let's consider a seventh. Ask and answer a question: If I applied the text in accordance with what I've come to believe it means, what about my life would be affirmed or changed?

Remember, it's okay to be affirmed by a biblical text. Some of us look only for how Scripture might challenge our beliefs. We need to be open to the comfort and affirmation the Scriptures sometimes provide. For example, most of us have found solace in Psalm 23.

That being said, don't be afraid to allow a text to challenge your core convictions and well-established habits of thought or deed. Perhaps you've had such an experience. A good friend and parishioner of mine once told me she laid aside her long-standing racism because the more she studied the life of Jesus, the more she realized she had been wrong. She went on to become a public advocate on behalf of minorities in her town.

Try asking the question, and go where the answer leads you.
