### 1 Pr. Safety Glasses. *For hammering tarps, wood strips on roof*

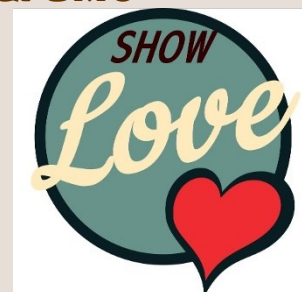
### 6 Clear Large Plastic Bags, 40-55 Gallon recommended (bundled)

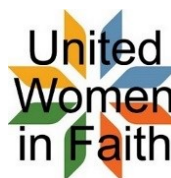
