### Sermon Notes: Thursday, August 21 and Sunday, August 24

The next student in the series, Student, is Mary of Bethany. Keeping track of all the Marys of scripture can be complex. There are up to seven different Marys of the Bible. Mary of Bethany is sister to Martha and Lazarus. She sat at Jesus' feet while her sister worked in the kitchen and anointed Jesus before his crucifixion. Mary was present when her brother was raised from the dead, pointing out to Jesus that if had arrived earlier then Lazarus would not have died. (John 11:1-3, 17-44).

Likely, we have had our moments of wrestling like Mary of Bethany. We want to know why Jesus did not show up earlier, why bad things happen, and if God cares. Scripture tells us that Jesus was delayed, so God's glory would be revealed. I am sure that with this answer, Mary may have still asked, "Could Jesus not have arrived earlier, and God's glory still be revealed?" There are times when we wrestle and wish that faith would be nice, with simple answers. In these times, we remember that Jesus cried with Mary of Bethany. Unfortunately, suffering is part of the human condition in this broken world, but also part of the human condition is the presence of a loving God, who is with us in our darkest moments.
