Proclaiming the Good News invites us to introduce people to the Jesus whom we know. We share because we love Jesus and we hope that others will love Jesus too. We might share because Jesus has made such a difference in our life, and we believe that Jesus can make a difference in the lives of others. We share to make Christ known. How might you make Christ known today?

by John Mark Comer


We are constantly being formed by the world around us. To be formed by Jesus will require us to become his apprentice.






Bible Studies & Small Groups for Adults





Mission Focus

Ladle of Love—Volunteer Opportunity

The GFUMC Ladle of Love Ministry is a weekly outreach dedicated to sharing nourishment, dignity, and hospitality with our community. Each week, a team of volunteers comes together to prepare and pack approximately **100 take-out lunches**, offering a simple but thoughtfully prepared meal to anyone who comes. A typical lunch includes a **sandwich, chips, fruit, and a dessert**—often an individually wrapped Little Debbie. At times, the menu may vary and include options such as **barbecue sandwiches, soup and sandwiches, burritos, or other hearty meals**.



Lunches are distributed **every Friday from 11:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon** at the **covered portico facing 6th Street**. There is **no request for names, identification, or proof of eligibility**—all are welcome. To ensure fairness and availability, **one lunch is given per person present**. Through this ministry, GFUMC seeks to meet immediate needs while extending Christ's love through compassion, generosity, and respectful service.

Volunteers are essential to this ministry's success. We are currently seeking a **team leader and volunteers for the third Friday of each month**, and **additional volunteers are also needed for other weekly teams**. If you would like to volunteer or learn more about the Ladle of Love Ministry, please contact the church secretary, **Susan Swann**, at **256-543-8200**.

GFUMC Clothes Closet Ministry

The GFUMC Clothes Closet Ministry is a welcoming outreach that provides free clothing to anyone in the community who has a need. **Donations of clothing are received throughout the year**, helping ensure that the Closet remains well stocked for all seasons. At present, **seasonal winter items** are especially needed, including **jackets, sweaters, hats, gloves, scarves, and socks**. Simply call the church office to schedule a time to drop off items.



A dedicated group of volunteers works behind the scenes to make this ministry possible. Volunteers gather from **9:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. on the Tuesday preceding each open day to sort, organize, and prepare donated clothing**. The Clothes Closet is thoughtfully arranged like a retail store, allowing guests to enjoy a dignified shopping experience. Some volunteers even use their creativity to design **attractive window displays**, adding a warm and inviting touch.

The Clothes Closet is **open to the public on the first and third Wednesday of each month from 9:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m.** All clothing items are **provided at no cost**, and there is **no requirement for names, identification, or proof of need**. Guests are simply invited to come in, browse, and select the **clothing styles and sizes that best meet their needs**. Through this ministry, GFUMC offers care, respect, and generosity to the community. **New Volunteers are always welcome!** Contact Susan Swann, 256.543.8200 for more information.






