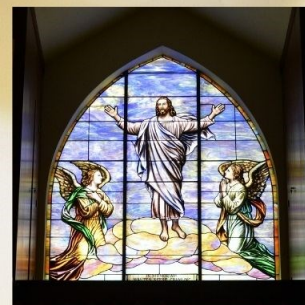

Sermon Notes: Thursday January 18 & Sunday January 21

This week we start a new series "Word from the Window" featuring the stained-glass windows of the church. The first window is "The Ascension" which is located over the Narthex. This window depicts Jesus as he ascended into Heaven. It was installed in 1936 along with nine other windows in the sanctuary and given in memory of Walter Reese Gramling and Mary Catherine Beason Gramling by their children. "The Ascension" was designed by Joseph Victor Llorens of Atlanta, Georgia.

For your daily dose of discipleship, I encourage you to spend time in the Scripture which inspired this window: Acts 1:6-11. As you do so, consider these questions for reflection: 1) What must it have been like as the disciples witnessed Jesus ascend to heaven?, 2) While Jesus has ascended to heaven, how do we experience his presence with us today?, and 3) Why do you think the beings appeared to challenge the disciples about why they were standing and staring at the sky?

Join us Sunday as we see the beauty and hear the story.

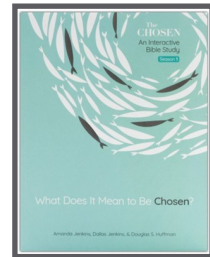

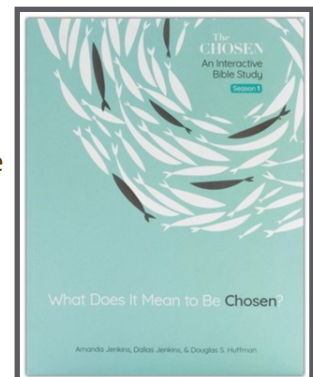

It's time to put in your King Cake orders for 2024. Once again, we are selling King Cakes from Randazzo's bakery in Slidell, LA. There are several flavors and two sizes in each option. Last year, we hoped to sell at least 100 cakes but due to your generosity and campaigning we sold 409. The bakery has a maximum order of 500 cakes per fundraiser.

This sale, we will be collecting orders through an online method only. We feel that this will be the best way to manage the orders and not exceed the maximum number allowed. Payment will be collected through PayPal or cash or check dropped off to the church within 24 hours of ordering. **PayPal Link: PayPal.me@FELC115**

The fundraiser is currently open, and all orders and money are due by Friday, January 19. This will give plenty of time to review all the orders and count the money before giving a grand total per item to the bakery. Sheila Freeman and I will be driving to Slidell to pick them up on Thursday, February 1.

January Mission Focus- UMCOR US Disaster Relief & Supplies for UMCNA UMCOR Disaster Relief Warehouse:

Your Mission Team will be leading the way to once again fill Tornado Buckets for the UMCOR Disaster Relief Warehouse in Decatur! This year, we will be collecting donations of items for the cleaning supplies and buckets so that those can then be divided up and packed!

You can help by donating multiple quantities of the same item, providing cleaning supplies, or by sponsoring a tornado bucket. *The estimated cost of the items for one tornado bucket is \$120. We hope to have lots of supplies and buckets ready to take to our Disaster Relief Warehouse*

Specific Items Needed to Complete a Tornado Bucket

- 1 Standard Size Claw Hammer (No Stubby hammers, framing hammers or hammers lighter than 16 Oz, please!)
- 4-4 oz Insect Repellant Spray Can
- 1 pair Safety Glasses
- 9-12 Tampons or Pads in a Zip Loc Bag
- Flashlight with batteries

- Liquid Laundry Soap Awesome brand. 42 oz (Dollar Tree)
 - Dish Washing Soap (14-30 oz)
 - 5 Scrub Buddies square scrub pads (5 Individual pads per bucket)
(No round scrubbers, no steel/copper scrubbers, and no Brillo pads please.)
 - Reusable Wipes— Brillo Basics are great. 2 packs of 9 per bucket. (No cloth wipes, no disinfectant wipes, no cloth rags, or wash cloths and no shop rags etc., please.)

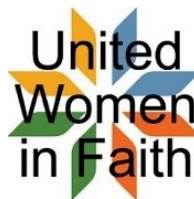

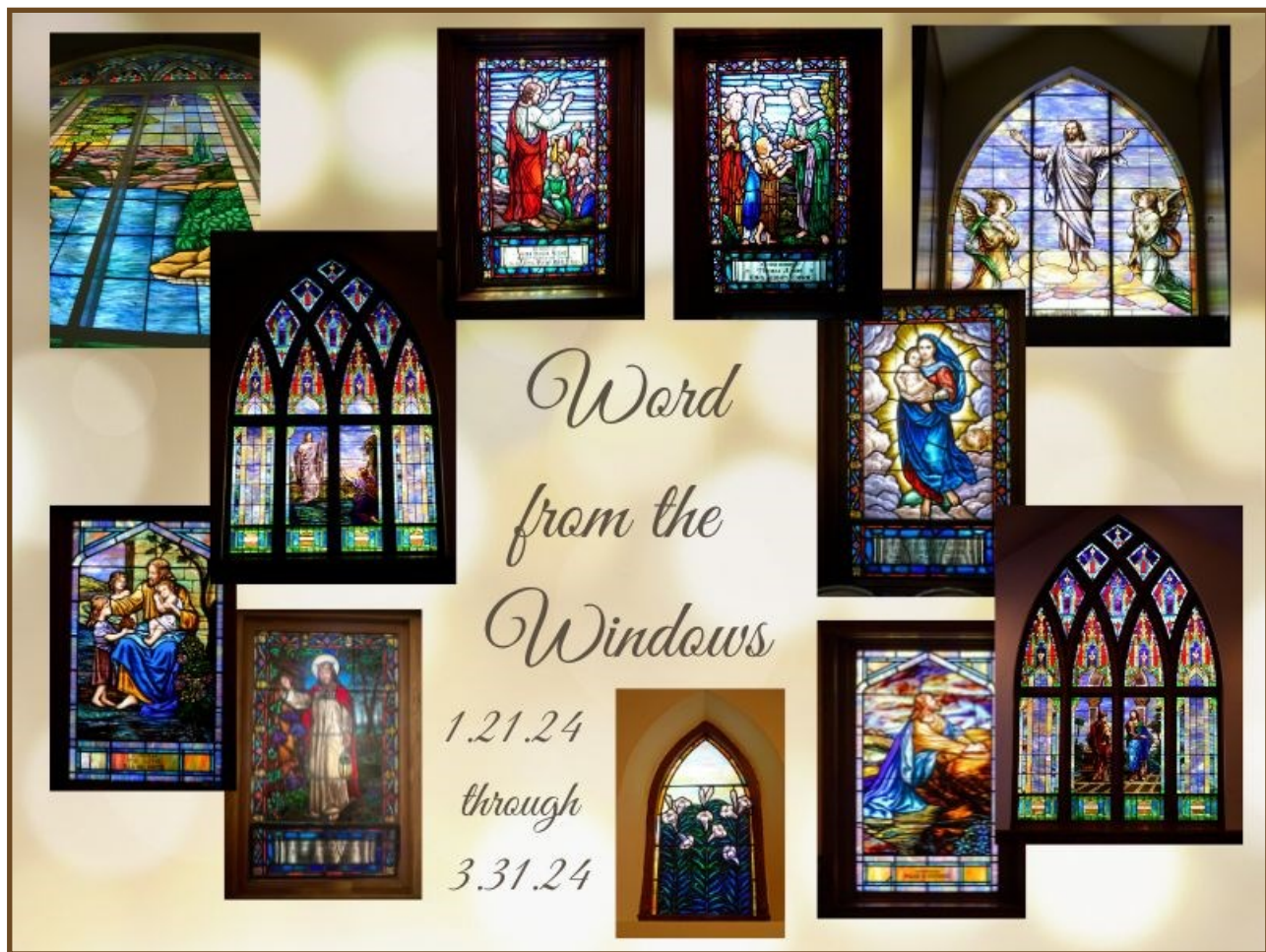

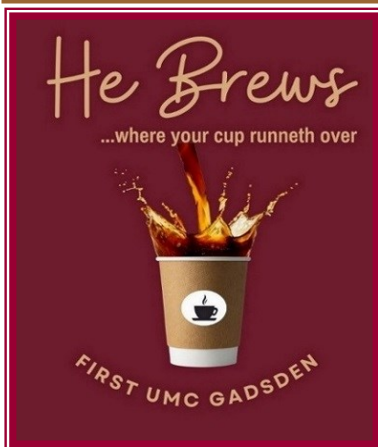
