Sermon Notes: Thursday, July 11 and Sunday, July 14, 2024

I urge, then, first of all, that petitions, prayers, intercession and thanksgiving be made for all people—for kings and all those in authority, that we may live peaceful and quiet lives in all godliness and holiness. This is good, and pleases God our Savior, who wants all people to be saved and to come to a knowledge of the truth. 1 Timothy 2:1-4

These are needed verses in the current political climate, with the upcoming political party national conventions and the presidential campaign in full force. We all could use this reminder from scripture from time to time, to pray for political leaders. We also need these verses as a reminder to pray for the leaders in the church.

July 9-12, I will be at Lake Junaluska in North Carolina as a delegate for Jurisdictional Conference. While we will not be electing new bishops, North Alabama will be assigned a new Bishop as Wallace-Padgett's tenure will end. Pray for Bishop Wallace-Padgett as she moves to a new episcopal area, our new Bishop, and our new District Superintendent, Rev. Alan Head. Leaders in the church are guiding the church in a very difficult and complex time. Let us support them with our prayers, petitions, intercessions and thanksgiving.

I'll be back with you Sunday for worship when we will welcome our new DS, Alan Head and his wife Missy. Alan comes to be our DS after pastoring Pleasant Hill UMC McCalla for seventeen years. He has also served as pastor at Trinity in Tuscaloosa, Reform, Anniston and Spring Garden-Union Grove. He is a graduate of the University of North Alabama and Candler School of Theology at Emory University.

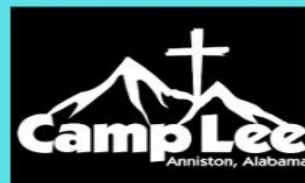

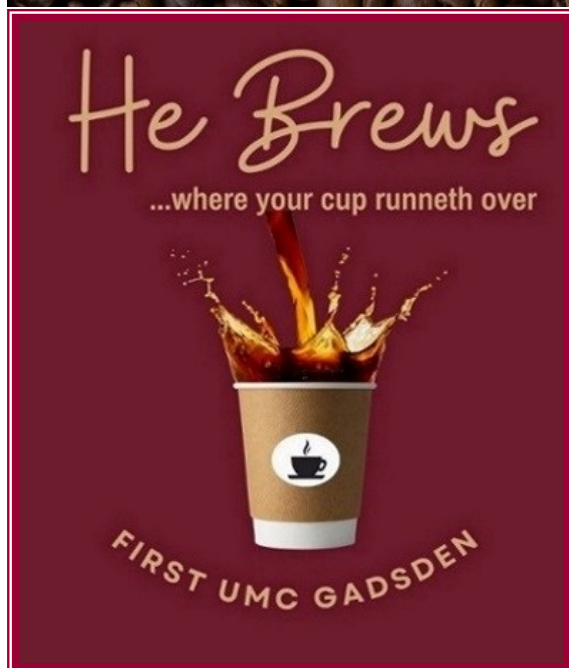

MITCH DuPONT

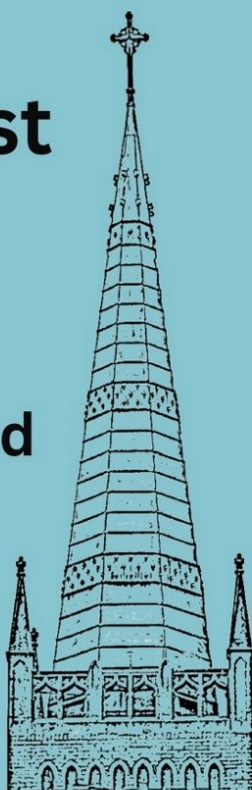

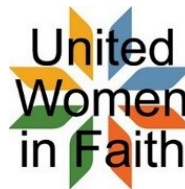
