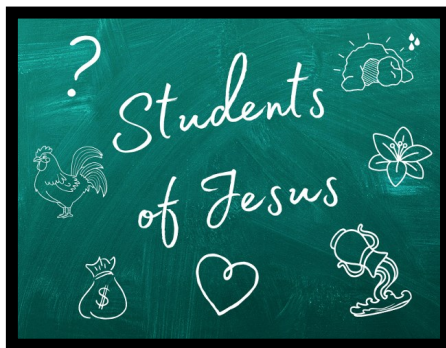

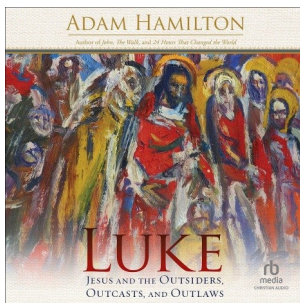
Sunday School: New Adult Series

Inviting Ministry Needs You!

Everyone in our church family is a part of our Inviting Ministries Team! Here are some ideas that might make it easier for you to welcome others to our church. Feel free to come up with other ideas or adapt these on your own. These are just to get you thinking about welcoming as a personal ministry, right there in the pew, and a lifestyle for our church.



- ♦ **Don't select the closest park to the church entrances. If you are able to navigate the parking lots and cross the street, leave the on street parking and closest parks for those who need easier access or visitors.**
- ♦ **Circle of 10*:** Greet anyone, member or guest, who comes within ten feet of you. Make a special effort to greet the people you don't already know within your Circle of 10.
- ♦ **Rule of Three*:** Please do not talk to other members for the first three minutes after the service. Talk only to those you don't know or people you know are guests. It takes guests about three minutes to exit the church after worship and we need to make sure someone has made contact with them before they leave.
- ♦ Don't be embarrassed if you're greeting a member and don't know that person's name—or be offended if someone doesn't remember yours. We need to offer grace to one another, just as we would to new people.
- ♦ **Whether you drink coffee or not, take time to stop by HeBrews in the Chestnut Foyer. Be sure to greet people there whom you may not know and enjoy the opportunity for fellowship!**

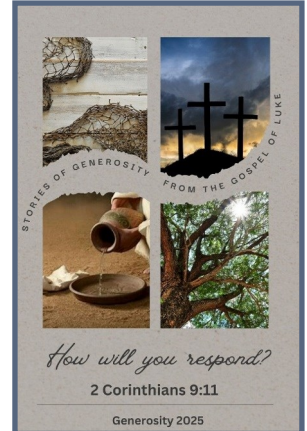
Out of town or working on weekends?
