

Sermon Notes: Thursday, August 1 and Sunday, August 4, 2024

We continue the sermon series, “This is Our Story. This is Our Song.” If you worshipped in-person during March, you know that we voted with brackets for our favorite hymns in the FUMC version of March Madness. This summer, the winners of the brackets will be the focus for the upcoming sermon series. As part of the series, I am writing a prayer inspired by the words of the focus hymn. This week’s hymn is “Here I Am, Lord.” As you prepare for worship, sing the focus hymn in your heart, keep the prayer on your lips, and renew your mind with the Scripture for the Sunday. If you are unfamiliar with the hymn, you can find the words online or in the United Methodist Hymnal on page 593.

Scripture: Isaiah 6:1-8

Prayer: *Lord of sea and sky. Lord who hears the people’s cry. For those who dwell in dark and sin, God’s hand will save. God who made stars and night. God who makes our darkness bright. Lord of snow and rain, who bears your people’s pain. You weep for love of us and too often we turn away. You can transform our stone hearts and give us hearts for love. Speak a Word to Us. Lord of wind and flame, who tends the poor and lame. Set a feast for us providing us with the best bread, satisfying our hearts and giving us life. Here we are, Lord. We are yours, Lord. We heard you calling in the night. We will go for you Lord if you lead us. We will hold your people in our heart.*







There will be a Meet and Greet at HeBrews on August 11.


Welcome Bishop Holston to the North Alabama Conference!

The 2024 Southeastern Jurisdiction has assigned Bishop L. Jonathan Holston as the resident bishop of the newly formed Alabama Panhandle Episcopal area beginning Sept. 1, 2024. This new Episcopal area includes the former Alabama-West Florida and Birmingham Episcopal areas. Its two annual conferences, Alabama-West Florida and North Alabama, will remain separate conferences sharing a bishop.

Bishop Holston has faithfully served the South Carolina Annual Conference (Columbia Episcopal area) for 12 years since he was elected a bishop in 2012. Prior to serving as a Bishop, he was a clergy member of the North Georgia Conference. He has a heart for mission, both at home and abroad, and an affinity for bringing people together in our shared mission of making disciples of Jesus Christ for the transformation of the world.

"It is an honor to serve these two areas," stated Bishop Holston. "Our United Methodist itinerant system is designed to allow the Holy Spirit to guide the work of the Episcopacy Committee. I am grateful for their tireless work and faith in my abilities to lead these two conferences. These two conferences have been collaborating for quite some time in order to best prepare for this moment. I look forward to meeting many of you in the coming months. I welcome your prayers in this season of transition as we dream of the mission and vision God would give us together."

Bishop Holston is married to Felecia Brown Holston. They have two adult children, son Karlton and daughter Brittany. Bishop Holston earned his Master of Divinity in biblical studies from the Interdenominational Theological Center at Gammon Theological Seminary in Atlanta, Georgia, in 1983. He also holds a Bachelor of Arts in religion from the University of Georgia in Athens, Georgia. During his ministry in North Georgia, Holston served as senior pastor of St. James UMC in Atlanta for seven years. Before that, he served as superintendent of the Atlanta-Decatur-Oxford District from 1997 to 2005. Other appointments include associate director of the North Georgia Conference Council on Ministries, senior pastor of Clifton UMC and pastor of Marietta Street UMC.


