Sermon Notes: Thursday, March 13, and Sunday, March 16

The image in our *Woven* series is a shamrock within the triangle. With St. Patrick's Day on March 17th, it is the perfect symbol for worship. Tradition says that St. Patrick used the shamrock to teach the doctrine of the Trinity. The shamrock is a trefoil, or a single design of three circles. It is set within a triangle with three identical sides, and angles. Thus, this image helps us recall One God in three persons.

Three is important number for the symbol and our faith. Three is the symbol of the Trinity and a number of wholeness. Jesus was resurrected on the third day. Jonah was in the belly of a big fish for three days and Jesus practiced earthly ministry for three years. Peter denied Jesus three times and the Ark of the Covenant held three objects. Three is also the number of relationships found in the Great Command (Matthew 22:36-40) These are the relationships with God, neighbor and self. As *School House Rock* told us, three is a magic number.

Consider completeness in relationships this week as you strive to love God fully, and love your neighbor as yourself? Which relationship needs your greatest attention this Lent?

Are you wanting to go deeper in your spiritual life? Consider a life-changing 72-hour retreat at Camp Sumatanga called the Walk to Emmaus. The Walk to Emmaus is a spiritual renewal program intended to strengthen the local church through the development of Christian disciples and leaders. The retreat is a 72-hour short course in Christianity, comprised of fifteen talks by lay and clergy on the themes of God's grace, disciplines of Christian

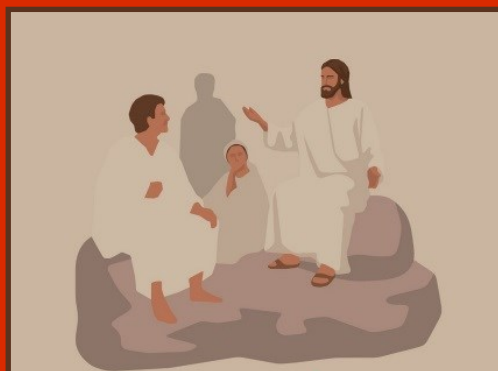
One of the greatest artistic assets of this church is one that we don't often notice: the needlepoint work on the kneelers at our communion rail. For almost fifty years, worshippers have knelt on cushions handcrafted by skillful hands. Each cushion is adorned with extraordinary needlepoint depicting the rich symbols of our Christian faith. Created in 1976 and restored in 2011, these cushions are a treasure that enhance our worship and guide us in faithful discipleship.

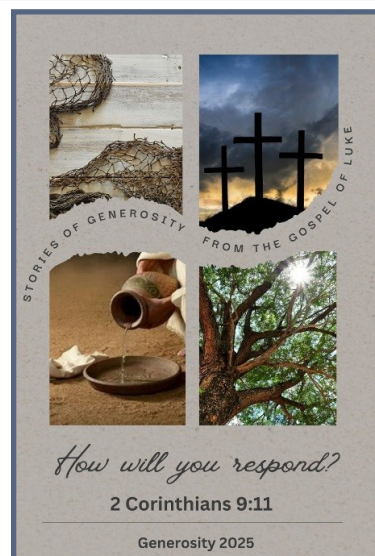

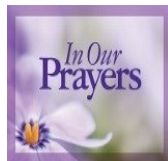
