"B-I-B-L-E that's the book for me" we sang at Vacation Bible School when I was a little tyke. And it is still sung at VBS. The Bible is very important for the church and for us as individuals.

So often when we hear the phrase "the Word of God" we think about the Bible, because we have been told so often that the Word of God is the Bible and that we should believe it; sometimes literally. But the Word of God is a person-Jesus Christ.



What difference does it make that we encounter the Word of God in a person? It is very important that we read the Bible, which tells us how to recognize the Word, what the Word teaches us, how we are to respond and that we are expected to be the Word for the rest of the world. But we encounter the Word of God in a person.

Walk to Emmaus Are you wanting to go deeper in your spiritual life? Consider a life-changing 72-hour retreat at Camp Sumatanga called the Walk to Emmaus. The Walk to Emmaus is a spiritual renewal program intended to strengthen the local church through the development of Christian disciples and leaders. The retreat is a 72-hour short course in Christianity, comprised of fifteen talks by lay and clergy on the themes of God's grace, disciplines of Christian discipleship, and what it means to be the church. One of the greatest artistic assets of this church is one that we don't often notice: the needlepoint work on the kneelers at our communion rail. For almost fifty years, worshippers have knelt on cushions handcrafted by skillful hands. Each cushion is adorned with extraordinary needlepoint depicting the rich symbols of our Christian faith. Created in 1976 and restored in 2011, these cushions are a treasure that enhance our worship and guide us in faithful discipleship.

This Lent, First United Methodist Church of Gadsden will be spending the season looking at the story behind the kneelers and the meaning of the symbols with *Woven*. The series will kick off on Ash Wednesday and conclude on Easter. Find your favorite symbol on the cushions, bring your curiosity, and join us for *Woven* this spring.




