What is a Jesse Tree?


A Jesse Tree is a symbolic representation of the genealogy of Jesus Christ, named after Jesse, the father of King David. It is used during the Advent season to illustrate the people, prophecies, and leading up to the birth of Jesus. Each day of Advent, a Bible story about someone from Jesus's family tree is read, and an ornament symbolizing that story is hung on the tree, linking the Old Testament to the coming of Christ.

There will be Wednesday morning Bible study on November 19 and Friendsgiving Bingo for adults that evening at 6 pm. No Bible Study (am or pm) on November 26th.







At the October 28th Finance Team and Board of Stewards meetings, the leadership unanimously voted for First United Methodist Church to resume our support of the United Methodist Church with 10% in connectional giving. This means that the church tithes (10%) from general fund receipts to the larger United Methodist Church. Not only is this a Biblical model, but it is considered our fair share support for the larger connectional structure. This means 10% of your giving supports United Methodist Ministry in North Alabama (such as administration, annual conference gatherings, educational events, direct missions, new church starts), United Methodist Global Missions, Global Administration for United Methodist Boards and Agencies, Educational Opportunities and Seminaries of the United Methodist Church, and Promotion of Interdenominational Cooperation. The result is that our witness goes well beyond the corner of 5th Street and Chestnut to have a far-reaching impact. Just as we can do more together as First United Methodist Church of Gadsden, so we can do more to impact global needs as a denomination.

Thank you for your support of First United Church of Gadsden. If you want to learn more about connectional giving, go to umc.org and explore *apportioned funds*. On that website, you will find specific ways that 10% of your giving is making a difference through the United Methodist Church.

“Building Upon a Solid Foundation,” our 2026 Generosity Emphasis, concluded on



November 16. This was a great celebration of generosity with commitments being turned in and wonderful church-wide brunch. Thanks to all who made this special emphasis a success. As of November 18, 50 commitment cards had been returned with a commitment of \$408,456.00. There was also a great commitment to continue to support First United Methodist Church of Gadsden with prayers, presence, gifts, service, and witness.

If you have not had an opportunity to turn in your estimate of giving card you may do so by placing your card in the offering plate, returning it to the church office, mailing it to the church office, or completing an online card (via the church app or website). The finance department will continue to receive those until the end of the year. Remember that your estimate of giving is held confidentially in the church finance office and is not legally binding. This is a commitment between God and you and helps the church plan for the coming year's budget. You should have received your *2025 Impact Report* in the mail. If not, please contact the church office. Hold on to this report and remember the impact that your prayers, presence, gifts, service and witness have on the church, Gadsden, and beyond. 


Celebration Worship, in the Chapel, 9 am, November 30 "The Jesse Tree" Rev. Sherri Reynolds

While Advent calendars are all the rage these days, First United Methodist Church is counting down this season with something ancient: The Jesse Tree. This historical way of marking off the days until Christmas, incorporates the biblical narrative, tradition, and decorating your tree. You begin with Creation on December 1 and end with the birth of Jesus on December 25. Each day of the countdown is represented by an ornament, a theme, a scripture reading, and a symbol. There are 25 themes which create a timeline leading up to celebrating Jesus' birth. To enhance this sacred time, the church has developed a devotional written by church members.

The Jesse Tree will be our emphasis this Advent season including sermon series, participation by our children's department, a Bible Study, emails and the devotion guide. It will be another beautiful season at First United Methodist Church of Gadsden as we explore the Jesse Tree.

Want to learn more? Rev. Sherri will be offering a more in-depth explanation in her sermon on November 30 at Celebrations in the Chapel. There will also be an accompanying Bible Study on December 3 and 10 at 11am (Gathering Room) and 6pm (208). Participants will get their own set of ornaments to decorate.
