Over the coming weeks, here's what I will teach in Sunday School in the church chapel:
"Turning the Other Cheek, When Facing the Narcissist".

1. Study of angelic forces (Jacob's Ladder and the encounter of Jesus and Nathaniel).
The significance of the story in our lives.
2. Angelic protection of Elisha and Israel when being attacked by the Arameans. How the attackers were blinded and wondered into Samaria in the presence of the king of Israel who in turn had a feast for them, thereby preventing a war.
3. The life story of Elfego Baca who became a deputy in 1880 who was said to have had 9 lives and could not be killed (I believe he had heavenly protection). He righted a terrible injustice against Mexican Americans as "mob justice" was the rule of law in the Texas territory. He was held up in a house and shot at by a mob. It was a 33 hour siege with over 4,000 shots fired into the house. The next morning, Elfego took time to cook tortillas for breakfast while still under siege.
4. Prayer and faith that moves mountains.
