### *From Pastor Anne:*

There have been a number of folks who have had questions about the notice on the screens when it's time to take Communion, which for the past two years has read "*In the United Methodist Church, all baptized Christians are invited to share in the Lord's Table.*" It was meant to be welcoming: to let people know that they did not need to be a member of this congregation, or even of the United Methodist Church, in order to receive Communion. This practice (known as "open communion" is observed by the United Methodist, Episcopal, ELCA, PCUS, UCC, Moravian, Disciples of Christ, and several Baptist denominations.

Back in 2012, Charles Heffling writing for *The Christian Century* pointed out that "The received understanding has always included a proviso, sometimes explicitly stated but often simply assumed: "All are welcome to receive" has been taken to mean "all Christians," which in turn has been understood as including all (and only) those who have been baptized with water in the name of the Trinity. In other words, an open eucharistic service has been open irrespective of denominational status but not of baptismal status."

Mr. Heffling made his observation in light of the fact that even the minimal standard of baptism in order to receive communion was beginning to fade away in some churches. The leading UM voice in this movement is that of Rev. Dr. Mark Stamm, who suggests that in a context of a deliberate and comprehensive program of discipleship, receiving Holy Communion might well come to *precede* Baptism as a means of encountering God. (*Let Every Soul Be Jesus' Guest*; Abingdon, 2006). It should go without saying that neither the Pastor nor the Communion servers are checking anybody's baptismal certificate at the Communion Table. Certainly anyone who is moved to do so is welcome to receive the body & blood of Christ at our services (though it is to be hoped that they will request the sacrament of Baptism expeditiously.) Nevertheless, seeking to err on the side of hospitality, the notice in the bulletin and on the screens will now read, "*In the United Methodist Church, all Christians regardless of denomination or church membership are invited to share in the Lord's Table.*"

## *Outreach News*

### Summary of 2025:

- Food Pantry- The pantry continued to “grow” in 2025 and we are now regularly serving 20-25 families a week. We get at least one new client per week now. November saw a temporary halt of SNAP benefits so additional new clients came around that time for a while. Luckily, our ecumenical donor family, as well as the community as a whole, really has stepped up enormously. Several food drives were held during the holidays and we are well stocked for the new year.
- Community Assistance- we provided financial assistance to 40 families, a few of them multiple times within the year. The number of other agencies with which we can coordinate efforts to help those in need also continues to grow as more and more have attended our quarterly meetings for networking. A Piatt County Housing Coalition was developed and meets here monthly to discuss ways we can increase the availability of low income housing in our community.
- Our \$7100 giving to United Methodist affiliated missions once more qualified MUMC as a Five-Star church. In addition, \$10,161.89 was given to various other missions locally, regionally, and abroad.
- Giving Tree collections yielded \$365 for Hope on 5<sup>th</sup> temporary housing shelter and \$535 for K9s for Warriors. The donations were able to be made before the year end.

**All in all, MUMC Outreach spent \$93,628.63 in 2025! Thank you to residents and businesses of the community, fellow churches, and, of course, to the MUMC church family for all your generous tithes to support our efforts.**
