Background & Context:

At the turn of the 20th century, the church took a hold of their role in the Great Commission that Christ left with us in Matthew 28:18-20. From 1900 where a staggering 54.3% of the world's population didn't have access to the gospel, through faithful obedience and empowered by the Holy Spirit that number fell to 27.7% in 2022. Unfortunately, that decline has reversed since 2022 and a slow increase in the un-evangelized has begun – **how will we respond?**
