Terms and Conditions

Payment Terms

Reservations can be secured with a deposit payment of \$500 per person. The total cost of the trip is \$3,600 per person, double occupancy. The single supplement is an additional \$1,000. You will receive an invoice for final payment, which is due by December 1, 2025. In the event that the payment is not received by that date, Church of the Resurrection reserves the right to treat the booking as canceled by the participant. In this event, the cancellation fees listed below shall apply.

Cancellation Policy

A participant who wishes to cancel a booking for any reason must notify the church office in writing. The cancellation charges set out below will be payable from the date Church of the Resurrection receives the notification of cancellation. The balance of the tour payment (after subtraction of cancellation fees) will be returned to the participant within 30 days after the receipt of the cancellation letter.

Prior to October 15, 2025: Fully Refundable

Between October 15 and December 1, 2025: Full deposit of \$500 will be charged.

After December 1, 2025: No refund (good travel insurance should cover full cost of trip).

Air Transportation

Please note that Church of the Resurrection is acting as a land agent only for this tour. You are required to book and pay for your own flight and you acknowledge that the flight is not part of any contract between you and Church of the Resurrection. You also acknowledge that if the tour were to be postponed, Church of the Resurrection is not liable for your flight cancellation or any other related costs. Our bus driver and guide will be at the Ben Gurion Airport in Tel Aviv within a certain window for arrivals and departures. Outside of this time, you will have to make your own arrangements to get to the hotel and agree to incur all costs related.

Accommodations

Accommodations and pricing are based on two persons sharing a room. Single rooms are subject to availability at the additional cost listed. If a participant cannot supply a roommate, the participant is responsible for the additional charge. Single rooms are limited to approximately 15% of the total number attending the trip.

Transfers and Baggage

Transfers between airports and hotels upon arrival and departure are included in the tour price, including the handling of one medium-sized suitcase per person, not exceeding 62 dimensional inches (length plus width plus height) and not weighing more than a maximum of 50 pounds. Due to limited luggage storage space on motor coaches, it is important that each person bring only one piece of checked baggage. In addition, a carry-on bag may be taken, which must be handled by the passenger at all times. Baggage allowance must also meet the requirements of your airline and are subject to change.

Meals

Breakfast and dinner will be provided daily. Participants will be responsible for lunches and any other snacks or beverages.

Sightseeing and Entrance Fees

All are included as indicated in the itinerary, using private motor coach or other conveyance, with local guides as necessary.

Tips and Taxes

Services charges and taxes on accommodations, and tips to guides, drivers, and hotel staff are included. Tips for lunches and personal services are not included.

Not Included in Tour Price

Lunches and tips, beverages with dinners, passport fee, checked baggage fees, and discretionary spending are not included.

Passport, Visa, and Health Requirements

A valid passport is required. If you do not have one, you should apply for one immediately, as they usually take some time to process. If you now have a passport, please verify that it is valid through August 20, 2026 (six months after the end of trip). Information on obtaining or renewing a U.S. passport can be found at travel.state.gov/passport. A visa for Israel is not required for US or Canadian citizens. Non US/Canadian citizens are responsible to fulfill entry requirements for countries to be visited by contacting the appropriate consulates. No immunizations or vaccines are required, but please check with your physician for their recommendation.

Rates and Fares Information

Rates are based on a minimum of 30 persons traveling together. Fewer tour participants will result in a price increase. The quoted tour price is based on the current rate of exchange. Fluctuation in the foreign exchange rate can result in a price increase.

Deviations

Any individual making a change in travel arrangements apart from the group program agrees to incur any additional air or land costs associated.

Tour Operator Itinerary Changes

The itinerary as outlined is an indication or sequence and sites to be included in the tour program. However, the tour operator, Shores Study Tours, reserves the right to alter or change the itinerary and/or the sites included should it be deemed necessary due to local conditions, time restrictions, or other circumstances.

Traveler Safety

Shores Study Tours is committed to safeguarding all groups traveling with them. They closely monitor the security situation and if the need arises, could change a group's itinerary. You may also monitor the US State Department warnings and advisories by visiting travel.state.gov. Media portrayals of Israel and the Middle East are not a reliable source of information for the safety of travel to Israel. Church of the Resurrection will be in regular contact with Shores Study Tours and alert you to any changes in conditions on the ground.

Disabilities and Dietary Restrictions

Participants with disabilities, mobility restrictions, or special dietary needs should indicate those on the registration form, and contact the church office in advance about whether those needs can be accommodated.
