

9 Things to Know when Starting a D-Group

1 - Use the Scripture! - Either Bible reading plan or a Book study

2 - Be accountable to one another - use the accountability questions

3 - Meet consistently - once a week, every week. Don't break the appointment. Early mornings are best

4 - Confidentiality. No Drama!!! - people will open up if they feel their responses are safe and secure from drama. Short of someone confessing a murder or suicide, keep things private! Within reason 😊

5 - School calendar commitment to a group of 3 to 5 - no more, no less. Honor your commitment!!

6 - Follow the H.E.A.R. method of study - Highlight, explain, apply, and respond to the text for the week

7 - Keep your group closed - however, have liberty to add a member to retain the 3-5 number if needed

8 - Make the group gender specific - all male or all female, NO co-ed groups

9 - Update leaders quick and often about progress, or needs/concerns you may have.
