### Vision

Our vision is that through a spirit of familiarity, rapport and trust, each person will leave better than they came.

### What are the St. John's Ministries?

At St. John's Men's Shelter and St. John's Women's Shelter, we provide adults experiencing homelessness with a safe and supportive place to sleep from November 1 through April 30, during the coldest time of the year. Supporting a person in their journey to self-sufficiency is the goal of our year-round daytime resource centers (Micah Center and Wellspring). Regardless of where they reside at night, individuals should have access to medical care, mental health treatment, support groups and resources designed to eliminate barriers and ensure they have the tools necessary to move towards their self-sufficiency goals. 
