February Mission: St. John's Ministries

"Our mission is to honor the dignity, restore hope and create lasting change for those experiencing homelessness or housing instability in the Green Bay community."

What are the St. John's Ministries?

At St. John's Men's Shelter and St. John's Women's Shelter, we provide adults experiencing homelessness with a safe and supportive place to sleep from November 1 through April 30, during the coldest time of the year. Supporting a person in their journey to self-sufficiency is the goal of our year-round daytime resource centers (Micah Center and Wellspring). Regardless of where they reside at night, individuals should have access to medical care, mental health treatment, support groups and resources designed to eliminate barriers and ensure they have the tools necessary to move towards their self-sufficiency goals.
