In Christ at the Table

The Lord's Table is unique and powerful. The sacraments of the Table and Baptism are opportunities to know God unlike any other. But what does Jesus' Table mean, practically, for the "average" Christian?

No one becomes a believer without believing that Jesus the Son of God died to redeem us from sin. Mental agreement to the Gospel and submission to the Lord Jesus brings us the benefits of salvation, but the <u>blessing</u> that gives strength for trials comes when comfort is whispered in our spirit by the Holy Spirit, saying "Abba, Father" (Rom. 8). We are invited to a "table prepared before me in the presence of my enemies. You anoint my head with oil. My cup runs over." (Ps 23). The Holy Spirit brings Jesus to us uniquely and we become convinced that we are indeed "in Christ" (Ep. 1.3), and refreshment comes to a weary soul. We are "IN CHRIST" and now we know it.
