Helps: \_\_\_\_\_ **The Second Article:** I believe in Jesus Christ, His only Son, our Lord, who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the Virgin Mary, suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died and was buried. He descended into hell. The third day He rose again from the dead. He ascended into heaven and is seated at the right hand of God, the Father Almighty. From there He will come to judge the living and the dead.

Helps: \_\_\_\_\_ **Titus 3:5** He saved us, not because of righteous things we had done, but because of his mercy. He saved us through the washing of rebirth and renewal by the Holy Spirit.

Helps: \_\_\_\_\_ **Matthew 28:19** Go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit.

Helps: \_\_\_\_\_ **Romans 10:17** Faith comes from hearing the message, and the message is heard through the word of Christ.

Helps: \_\_\_\_\_ **John 3:16** For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life.

Helps: \_\_\_\_\_ **John 15:16a** You did not choose me, but I chose you and appointed you to go and bear fruit—fruit that will last.

Helps: \_\_\_\_\_ **Matthew 5:16** Let your light shine before men, that they may see your good deeds and praise your Father in heaven.

Helps: \_\_\_\_\_ **Matthew 5:48** Be perfect, therefore, as your heavenly Father is perfect.

Helps: \_\_\_\_\_ **The Eighth Commandment:** You shall not give false testimony against your neighbor.

Helps: \_\_\_\_\_ **John 8:31b,32** “If you hold to my teaching, you are really my disciples. 32 Then you will know the truth, and the truth will set you free.”

- 5.) The Temptation of Jesus: Matthew 4:1-11
- 6.) Jesus Teaches Nicodemus: John 3:1-21
- 7.) Jesus Teaches about Prayer: Matthew 6:6-15, 7:7-12; Luke 18:1-8

## Bible Story Rubric

### Overall Tone (0-2) \_\_\_\_\_

- 0 - The story was retold in a way that was disrespectful
- 1 - The story was treated fancifully
- 2 - The story was retold in a way that was respectful an appropriate of the Word of God

### Setting/Bible Reference (0 – 3) \_\_\_\_\_

- 0 - There was no setting or Bible reference given.  
(example: “There was once a man named Noah...”)
- 1 - The Biblical setting was established, but no Bible reference given.  
(example: “Some time after Adam and Eve sinned their children became more and more corrupt and fell into unbelief until there was only one believer left named, Noah...”)
- 2 - The Biblical setting was established, and the Bible reference (as a book) given.  
(example: “In the book of Genesis it records how after Adam and Eve sinned their children became more and more corrupt and fell into unbelief...”)
- 3 - *The Biblical setting was established, and the Bible reference (as a chapter and book) given.*  
(example: “In Genesis chapters 6-9 it records how after Adam and Eve sinned their children became more and more corrupt and fell into unbelief...”)

### Orderliness (0-3) \_\_\_\_\_

- 0 - Retelling of events so mixed up as to make story unrecognizable or incoherent
- 1 - Events were retold, but in a mostly mixed up order
- 2 - Events were retold, with only a few details out of order
- 3 - Events were retold in a clear and orderly way, faithful to Biblical narrative

### Detail (0-4) \_\_\_\_\_

- 0 - Few or no meaningful details were given  
(example: “Noah was a man who lived a long time ago...”)
- 1 - Some details were given, but inconsistent with the Bible story  
(example: “Noah had five daughters...”)
- 2 - Some general details were given, consistent with the Bible story  
(example: “Noah had some sons...”)

3 - Several details were given, consistent with the Bible story

(example: "Noah had three sons...")

*4 - Several precise details were given, consistent with the Bible story*

(example: "Noah had three sons named Shem, Ham, and Japheth...")

**Application to faith and life (0-4) \_\_\_\_\_**

0 - No connections were made between the Bible story and faith and life

1 - Connects to faith and life were vague or generic

(example: "This story means a lot to me and will really strengthen my faith...")

2 - A connection was made to faith and life

(example: "The story of Noah tells me how much it pains God when I sin...")

3 - Several specific and connections were made to faith and life

*4 - Several specific connections were made to faith and life and ultimately to the larger story of God's plan of salvation in Jesus*

(example: "Seeing how God saved Noah and his family reminds me that although I am also a sinner who deserves God's judgment, he has rescued me from sin and death by sending Jesus to be my Savior and putting faith in my heart. Just like the ark saved Noah and his family in the midst of an ungodly generation, he will also save me and keep my faith in him alive. One day he will come again to judge those who don't believe and to bring me and all who believe to eternal life in heaven.")
